

# Angel's wings and halo (Christmas): Assembly Instructions

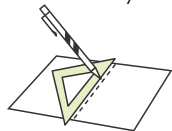

### ■ Assembly Instructions: Four US letter sheets (No.1 to No.4)

\*Build the model by carefully reading the Assembly Instructions, in the parts sheet page order.



\*Hint: Trace along the folds with a ruler and an exhausted pen (no ink) to get a sharper, easier fold.

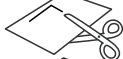
### Assembly Instructions



**Mountain fold(dotted line)**  
Make a mountain fold.



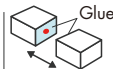
**Valley fold(dashed and dotted line)**  
Make a valley fold.



**Scissors line(solid line)**  
Cut along the line.



**Cut in line(solid line)**  
Cut along the line.



The glue spot(colored dot) shows where to apply the glue.

**● Glue spot(Red dot)**  
Glue parts with the same number together.

**● Glue spot(Green dot)**  
Glue within the same part.

**● Glue spot(Blue dot)**  
Glue to the rear of the other part.

#### Tools and materials



Scissors, set square, glue(We recommend stick glue), pencil, used ballpoint pen, toothpicks, tweezers, (useful for handling small parts)

#### Assembly tip



Before gluing, crease the paper along mountain fold and valley fold lines and make sure rounded sections are nice and stiff.

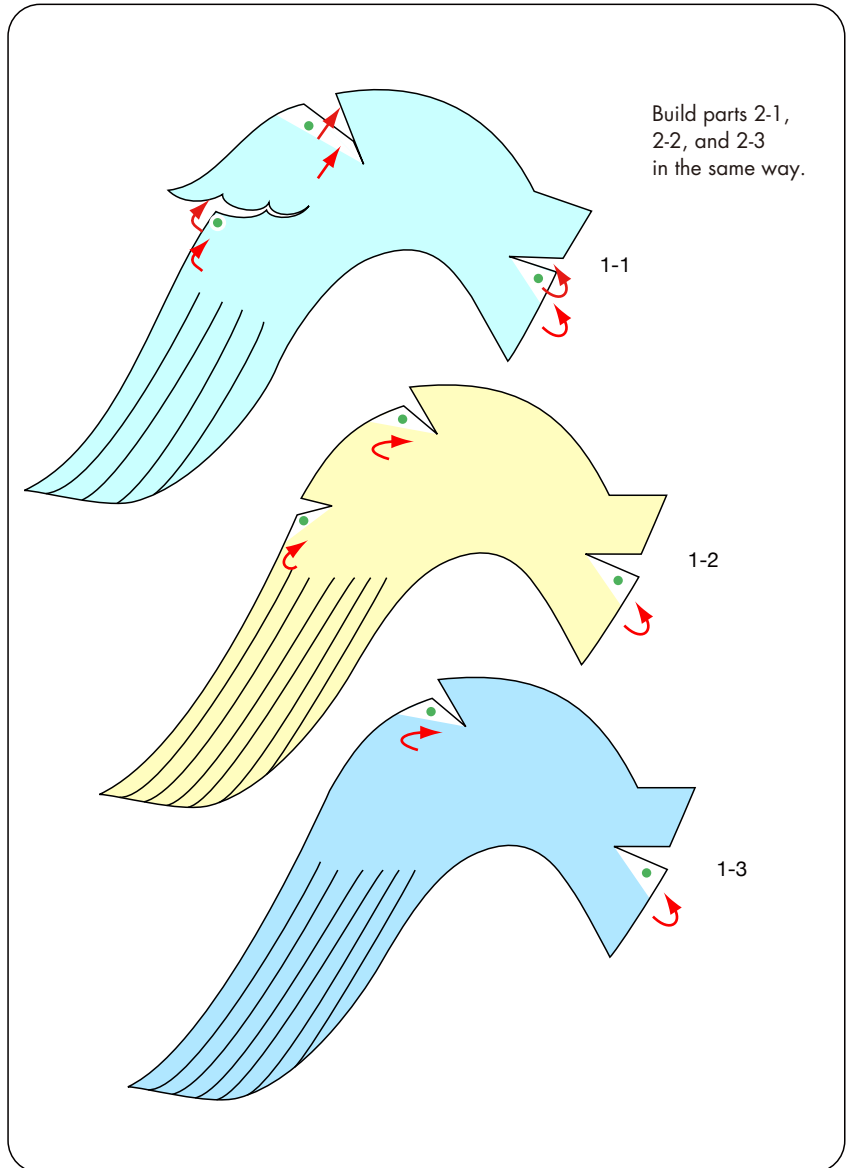
#### Caution



Glue, scissors and other tools may be dangerous to young children so be sure to keep them out of the reach of young children.

Before starting assembly: Writing the number of each section on its back side before cutting out the sections is highly recommended.  
(\* This way, you can be sure which section is which even after cutting out the sections.)

→ Indicates where sections should be glued together.



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Build parts 2-1 through 2-8 in the same way.

Give the tips of the wings a slight curve.

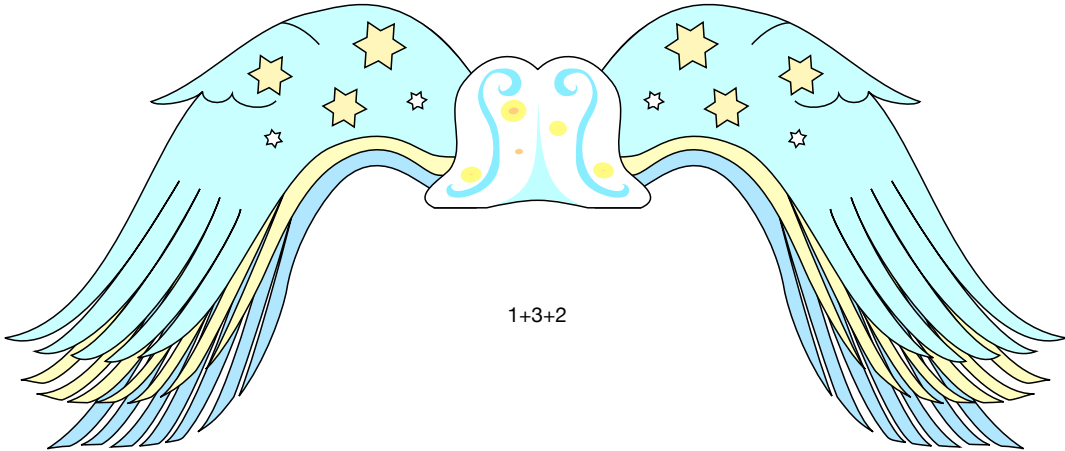
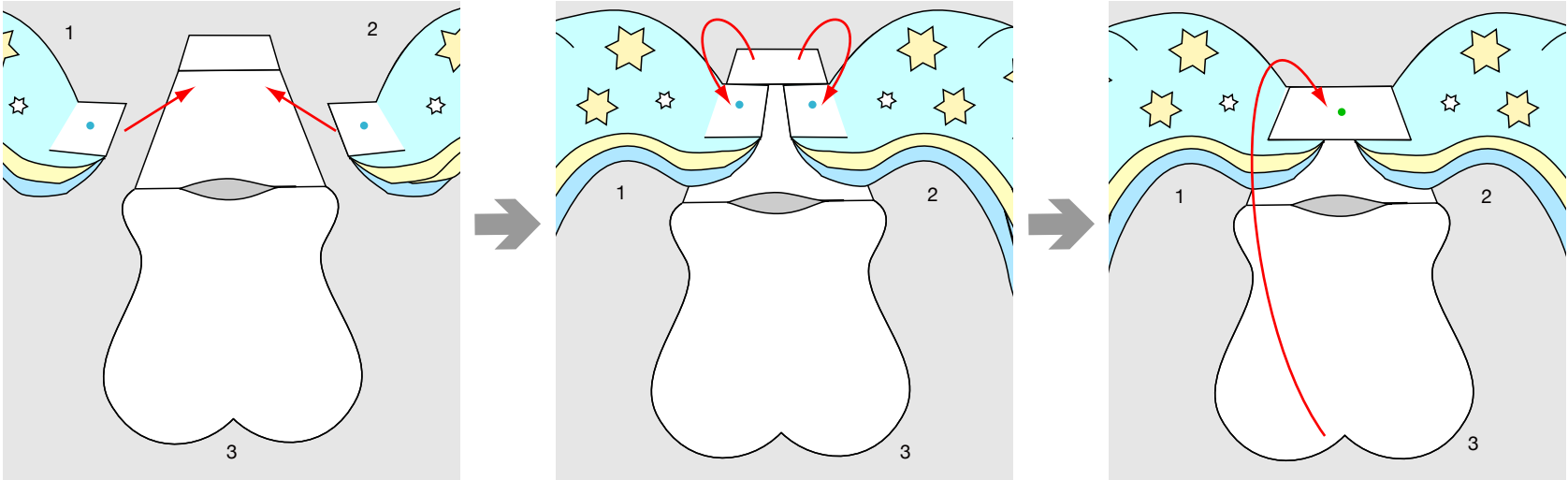

After bending into an "A" shape, cut off the  parts framed by line, as shown here.

Connect the wings with a thread of your choice, as shown above. Make loose knots.

Your angel's wings are finished!

This angel's halo can fit heads up to 60 centimeters in circumference. Cut off the decorations at the left end of part 5-3 to shorten the halo (one centimeter per decoration).

Build parts 5-1, 5-2, and 5-3 in the same way.

Leave the rear side of one glue tab unglued.
