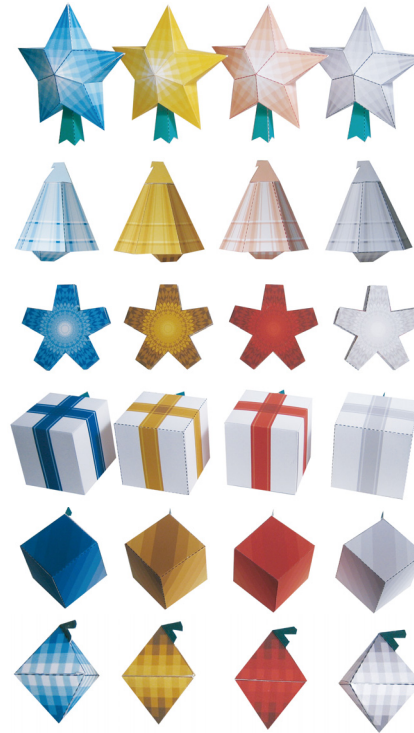

Ornaments are provided in six types of four colors each. Build as many of the ornaments you like in your favorite colors to decorate your tree.

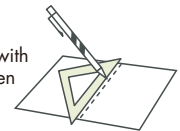
Before starting assembly:  
Writing the number of each section on its back side before cutting out the sections is highly recommended.  
[\* This way, you can be sure which section is which even after cutting out the sections.]

- Indicates where sections should be glued together.
- Indicates where to insert sections.  
Do not glue the sections together.
- Indicates sections that should be glued first, then cut out.

### ■ Assembly Instructions: Three US letter sheets (No.1 to No.3)

\* Build the model by carefully reading the Assembly Instructions, in the parts sheet page order.

\*Hint: Trace along the folds with a ruler and an exhausted pen (no ink) to get a sharper, easier fold.



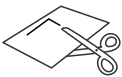
### Assembly Instructions



**Mountain fold (dotted line)**  
Make a mountain fold.



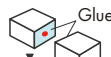
**Valley fold (dashed and dotted line)**  
Make a valley fold.



**Scissors line (solid line)**  
Cut along the line.



**Cut in line (solid line)**  
Cut along the line.



The glue spot (colored dot) shows where to apply the glue.

**● Glue spot (Red dot)**  
Glue parts with the same number together.

**● Glue spot (Green dot)**  
Glue within the same part.

**● Glue spot (Blue dot)**  
Glue to the rear of the other part.

#### Tools and materials



Scissors, set square, glue (We recommend stick glue), pencil, used ballpoint pen, toothpicks, tweezers, (useful for handling small parts)

#### Assembly tip



Before gluing, crease the paper along mountain fold and valley fold lines and make sure rounded sections are nice and stiff.

#### Caution



Glue, scissors and other tools may be dangerous to young children so be sure to keep them out of the reach of young children.

Since there are no glue tabs on this side, determine the appropriate gluing spot by inspection.

Fold the glue tabs gently when gluing (folding with excessive force will make it hard to glue the pieces in place).
