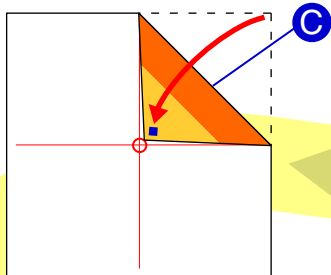
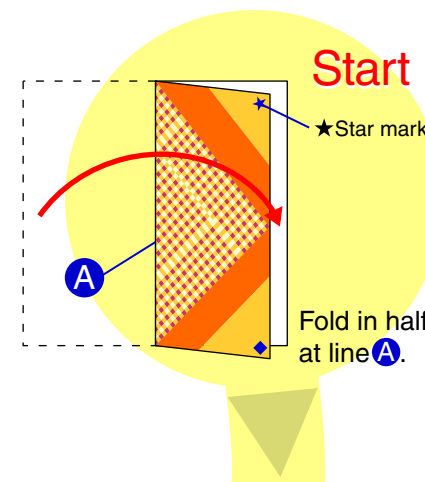


Box [A4 size 4pages]

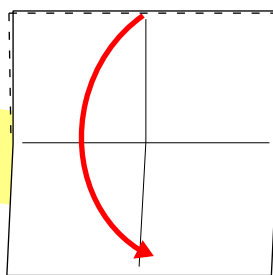
There are various types of origami which have been done in Japan since ancient times.

With this Box pattern, you can make a handy square box, just right for storing small objects.

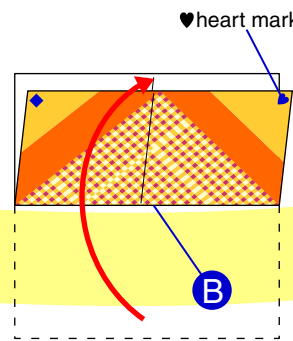
● The letters in blue circles indicate the fold lines. They are also shown on the practice sheet.



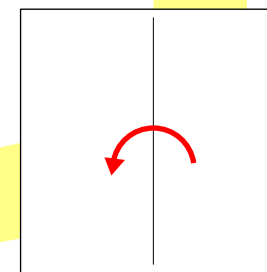
Align the corner with the center mark and fold along line C.



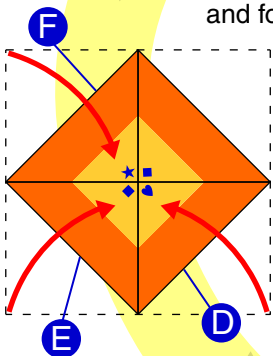
Unfold the paper and flatten.



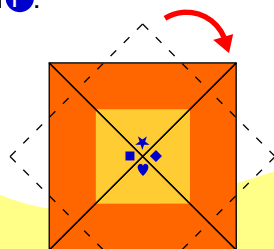
Fold in half at line B.



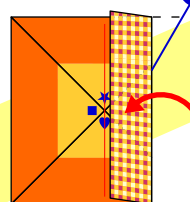
Unfold the paper and flatten.



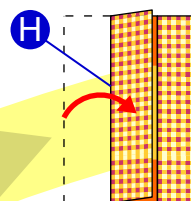
Align the other corners with the center mark and fold along lines D, E, and F.



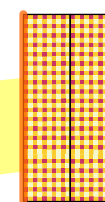
Rotate the paper 1/8 turn so the edges are horizontal and vertical.



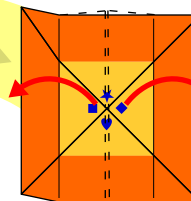
Fold along line G, so that the right edge is now aligned with the center line of the square.



Fold the left side in the same manner along line H.

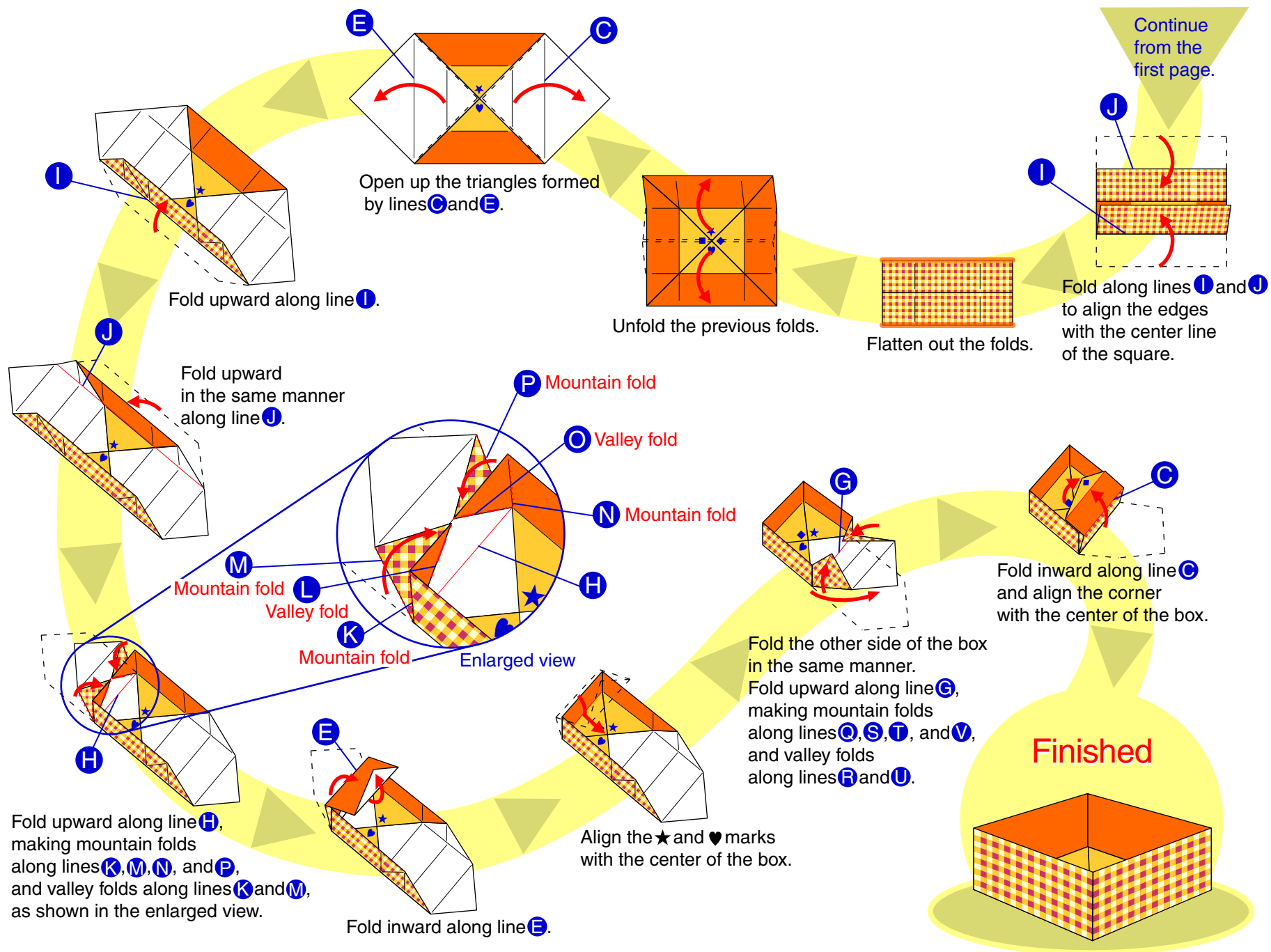


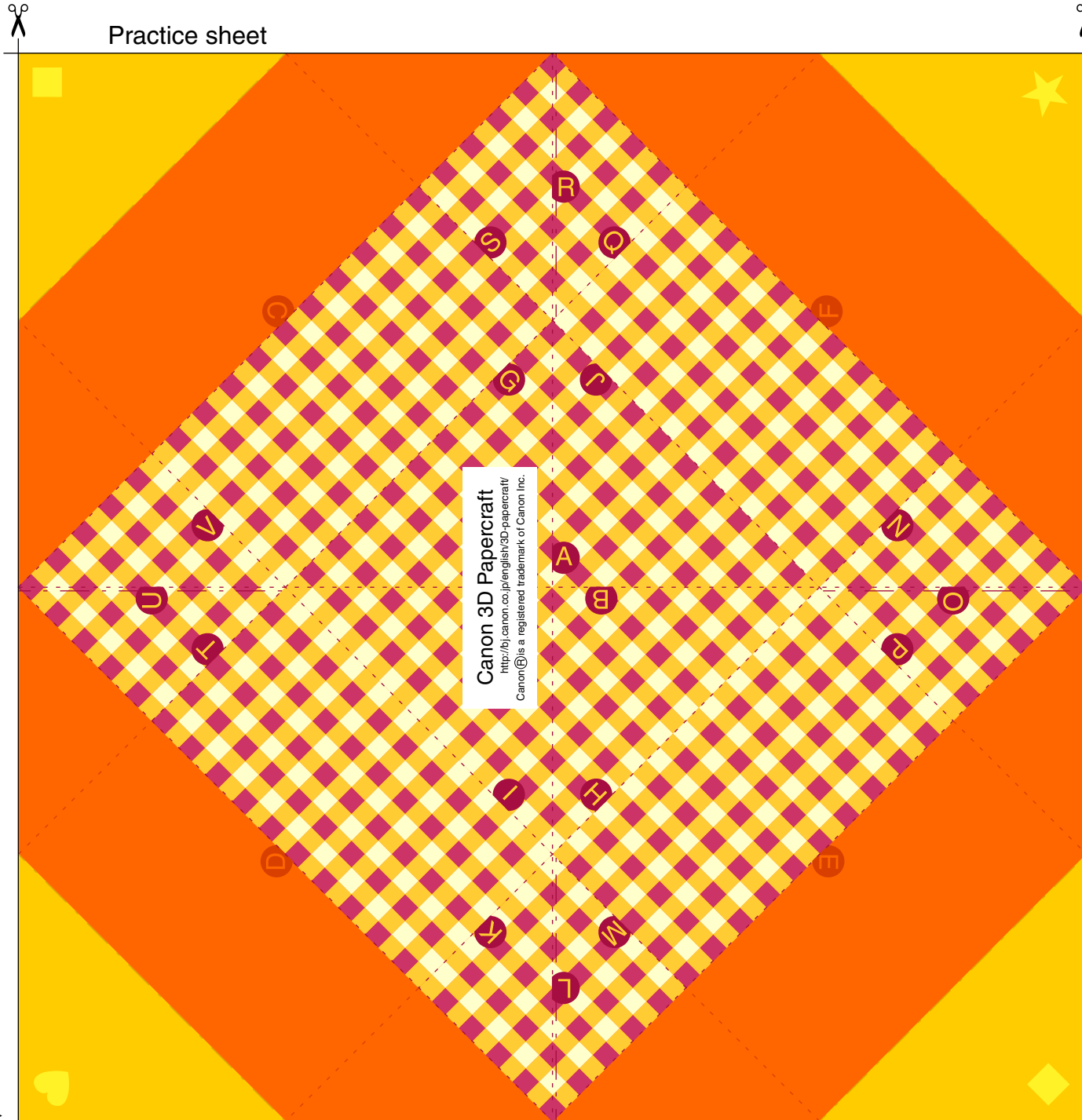
Flatten out the folds.



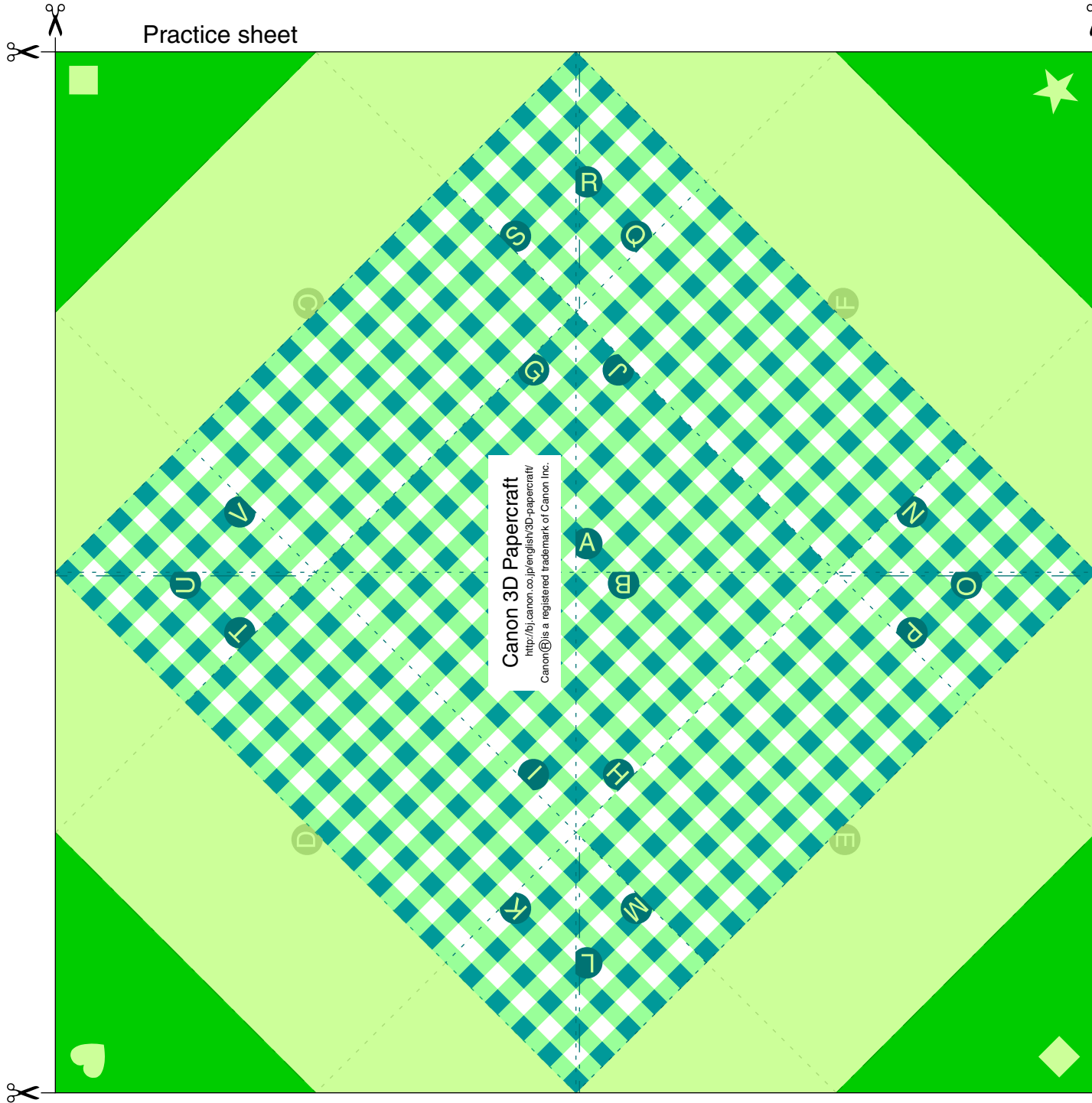
Unfold the paper and flatten.
