CATWALKS



The Catwalks can be placed on top of wall sections for additional movement width. You can also place them in-between double high wall sections as a midwall catwalk. Corner catwalk sections are included for optimal design flexibility and for linking awkward corners. Use your imagination and I'm sure you'll come up with a multitude of uses for these handy little models.



Cut, sco<mark>re and fold your models as noted.</mark>

Apply a bead of glue to the inside edges of the catwalk section and then a zigzag pattern down the middle.





Fold over and apply pressure to all edges and corners. Be sure to squeeze out any air bubbles and distribute the glue evenly.



Once dry, cut away any remaining white space. You may also wish to cut free three sides of the trap door so that it opens and closes.

Fold over and glue the catwalk supports.

Once dry cut away the remaining white space.





Apply the supports as shown.



You can now glue your catwalk section to the top of any standard wall or in-between double high wall sections.
