

c urtain arch










The Curtain Arch wall sections can be placed at the base of walls and buildings for variation. These sections can also be used as basic structures (Smithshop, Stables). For additional flexibility these structures can also be glued back-to-back to create a completely new building type.



Cut, sco<mark>re and fold y</mark>our model as shown.

Apply a thin but even bead of glue around the inner edge and center of the model (as shown).





Fold over and burnish the wall section. Make sure to squeeze out any air bubbles and spread the glue to every edge/corner.



Once dry cut away the internal white space from the arch sections.

Apply a thin bead of glue to the side wall tab.





Flip the model over and apply pressure to the tab connecting it to the roof.

Repeat the above steps on the opposite side.



Take a few seconds and "Edge" your models with a dark felt. The end result is worth the extra minimal effort!
