


e xterior stairs





EXTERIOR STAIRS




Matching the height of the standard wall section these stairs come in both right and left sweep configurations. While not perfectly to scale they provide enough space on each stair to accommodate any figure base you might have. Perfect for fierce multi-leveled combat!



Cut, score and fold the stair sections as noted.

Glue the base stair insert tab to the bottom of the first stair.





Apply an even coat of glue to the first step insert.

Apply the step insert under the first stair section. Use your ruler as a supporting back to apply pressure to the stair section.



Continue the above process until all six stairs are glued in place.

Glue the top tab to the inside of the top stair.





Apply a bead of glue along the vertical tab and attach to the railing wall section.



Apply a thin coat of glue to the backside of the stair guard rail as shown.

Flip the model over and apply pressure to the rail making sure to force glue to all edges and corners.

Glue the final base stair tab in place as shown.





Take a few seconds and "Edge" your models with a dark felt. The end result is worth the extra minimal effort!
