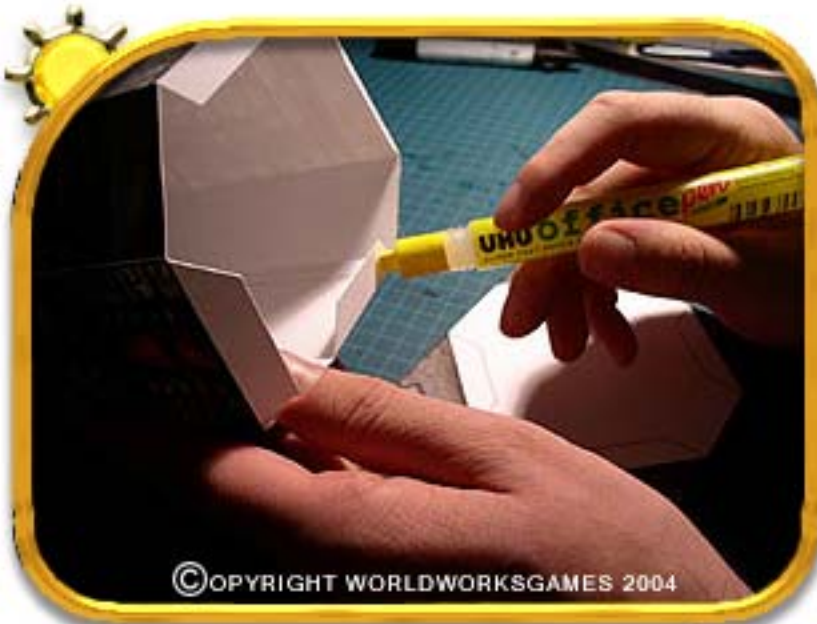
Simple Tower



SIMPLE TOWER



If you don't have the time or patience to create our full fledged "complex tower" or you simply need additional corner points then the simple tower is for you. You will quickly turn out these tower sections and before you know it your castle complex will be immense! You can also use them as placeholders and swap them out with a complex tower if your players decide to "have a look inside".

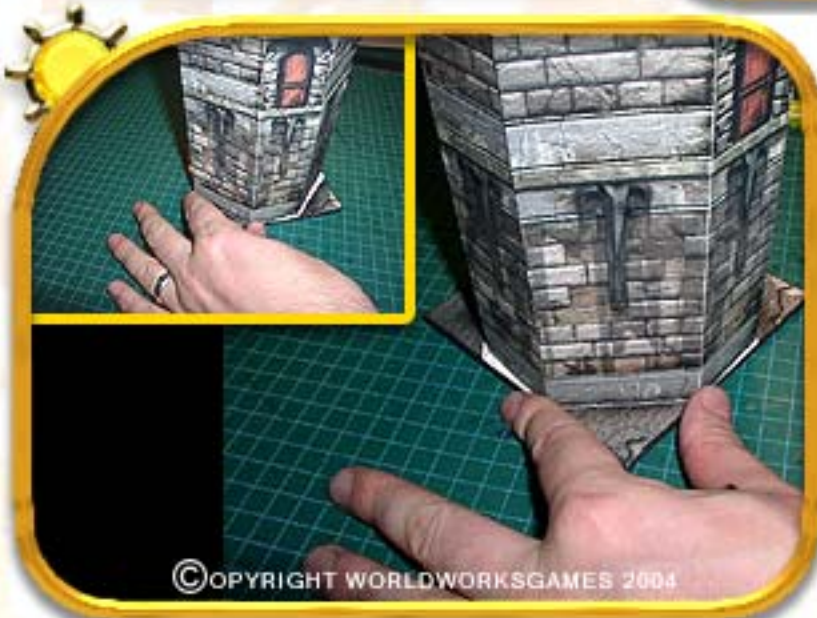


Cut, score and fold both tower walls. Glue “**simple tower wall 1**” to “**simple tower wall 2**”. If you want a blank tower (no doors) simply print two copies of wall 2.

Mount your “simple tower base” using the techniques described in the “**Basing**” tutorial located in the “**Masterboard/PaperLinX**” folder.

Apply a bead of glue to the first tab on the bottom side of your tower.

Reach your hand down the center of the tower and apply pressure to the first tab in the area marked on the base.



With your other hand be sure the tower is flush with the mounting base. You don't want any overhang.

Give the first tab a minute to dry before proceeding to the next step.

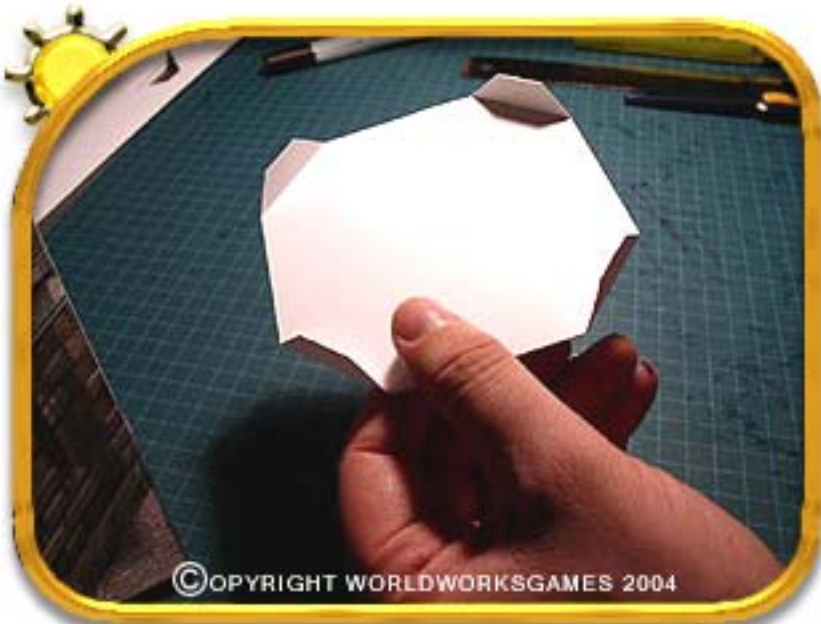


Push back the tower to reveal the next glue base area. Apply a bead of glue on base tab and once again push your hand down the center of the tower. With your other hand check to make sure the tower is not overhanging the base.

Allow for a short drying period.

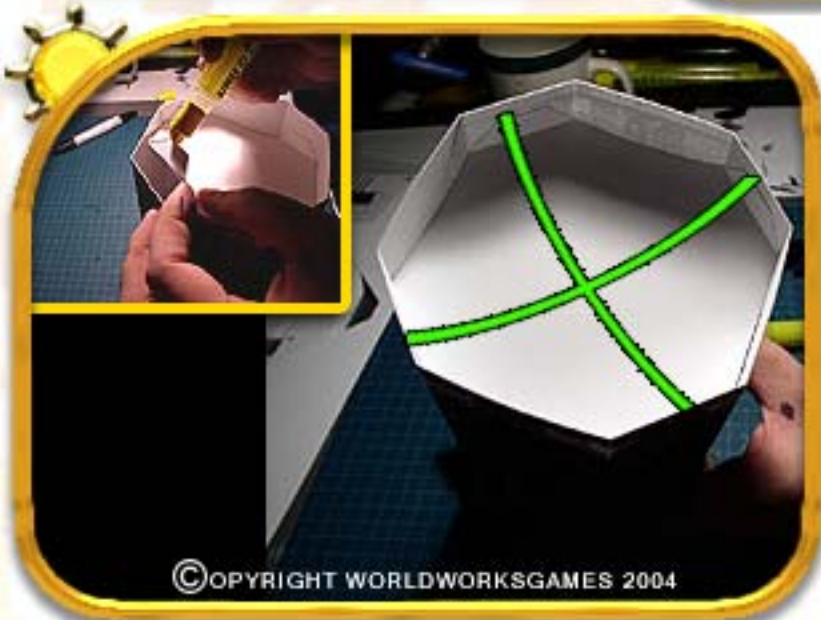
Continue working your way around, pushing the tower aside until you have secured all of the remaining tabs.





Fold the edges of the “tower bracing” as shown.

Glue the first tab of the tower brace and insert into the upper half of the tower. Try to keep the support roughly 1-inch from the top of the tower on all sides.



Pull back each remaining tab in turn, gluing and applying pressure.

The support insert will have a slight bend to it creating an outward pressure and keeping the upper tower solid.

Thats it! Now go build some tower toppers!
