



| MODEL TYPE: | TERRACE - FRONT |

This model is the heart of ArenaWorks. Three different types are included, the "Door", {seen above}, the "Plain" and the "Grill" fronts. Mix and match them with the five different backs {shown below} for your own custom arena plan.



STEP 1:

Cut and score your models as noted paying close attention to areas marked with reverse side scoring arrows. Please be accurate in your cutting and scoring, this model has tight tolerances. Fold everything loosely. Gently "pop" in the stairs in the center.




STEP 2:

Run glue along the back of the wooden railing and press flat. Before the glue sets bend the railing up 90 degrees, align it as in the indicated area below.



STEP 3:

Apply glue to the support tabs for the upper terrace surfaces; align the top and press onto the tabs.



STEP 4:

Attach the loose right end cap to the lower wall and glue the terrace floor to the tabs on the side. While it dries, select a back.
