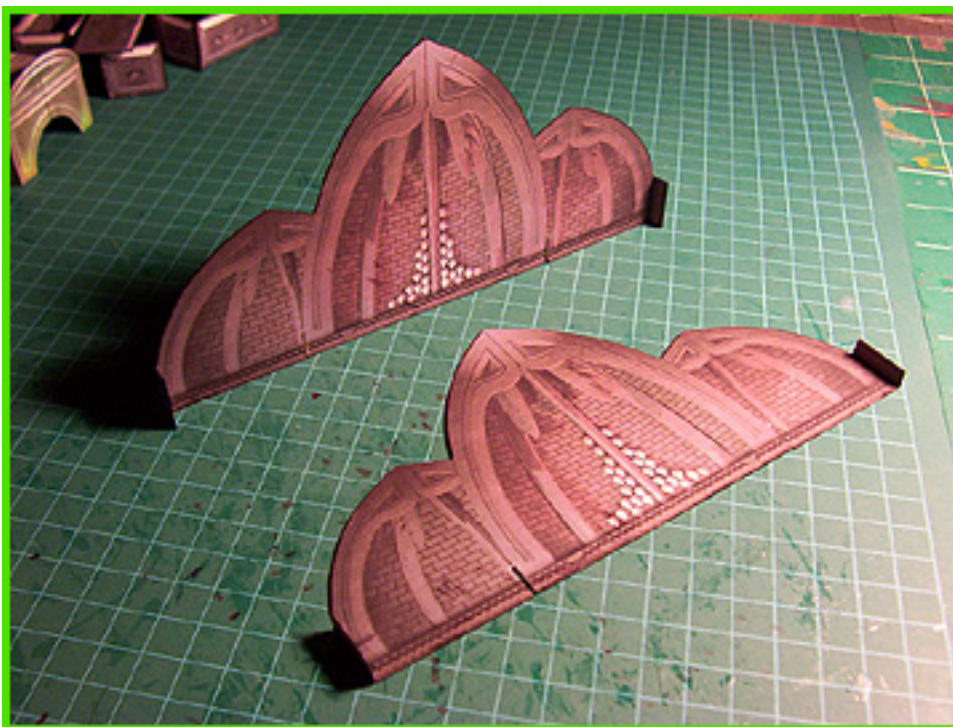




MODEL TYPE:	CHAMBER CEILINGS
DIFFICULTY:	2 out of 5 <i>(Curved cuts)</i>
APPROX BUILD TIME:	Quick – 5 to 10 minutes <i>(Time may vary depending on skill level)</i>
DUPLICATIONS <i>(Suggested):</i>	2 to 4
EDGING COLOR:	Gray or Black <i>(What is “Edging”? Please refer to the included “Beginners Guide”).</i>



STEP 1:

Cut and score your model as noted. **DO NOT REMOVE** the curved white space at this time. Fold over and glue the longest central line of each wall section (image appearing on both sides). Be sure that you apply an even but thin bead of glue to one entire side of the inside wall (reverse white side). When burnishing (applying pressure) be sure to push the glue to all corners and edges. Allow a one-minute dry time.

STEP 2:

Cut away the remaining white space and fold the end Clip-it tabs inward 90-degrees. Don't forget to remove the base slits. These slits are utilized when extending the height of a standard 7-inch wall section. More information in “Bringing it all together”.
