## CORRIDOR DOORS AND BLOCKERS



**Difficulty Rating (Out of 10): 3** (This is a very basic but highly useful model intended to block off certain passages or to add door elements where needed)

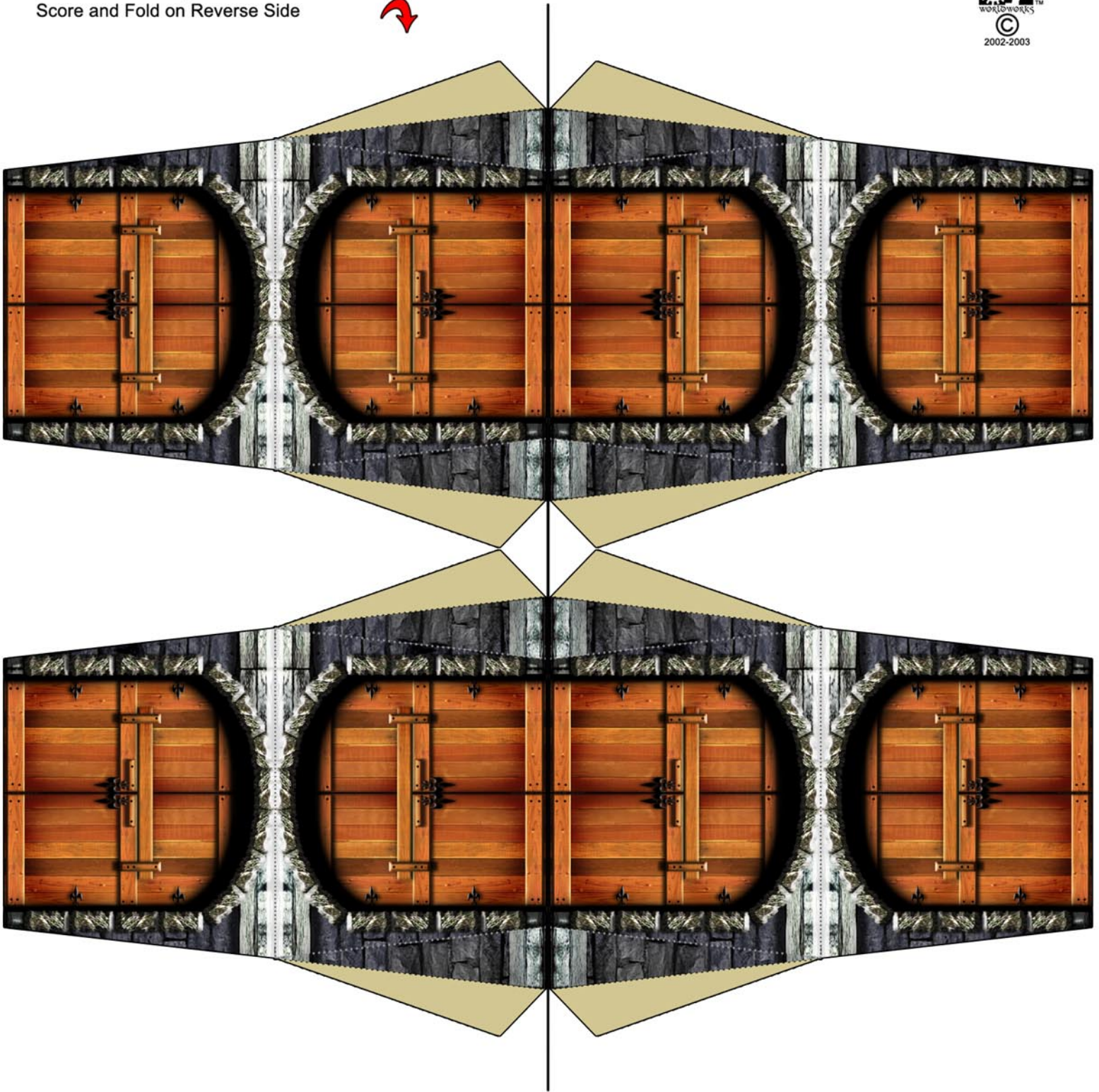
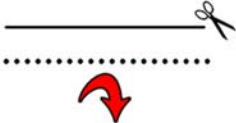
**Recommended Duplications: 12** (This really depends on how monstrous and or restrictive you want your dungeon to be. Creating 12 doors and blockers takes very little time)

### Steps:

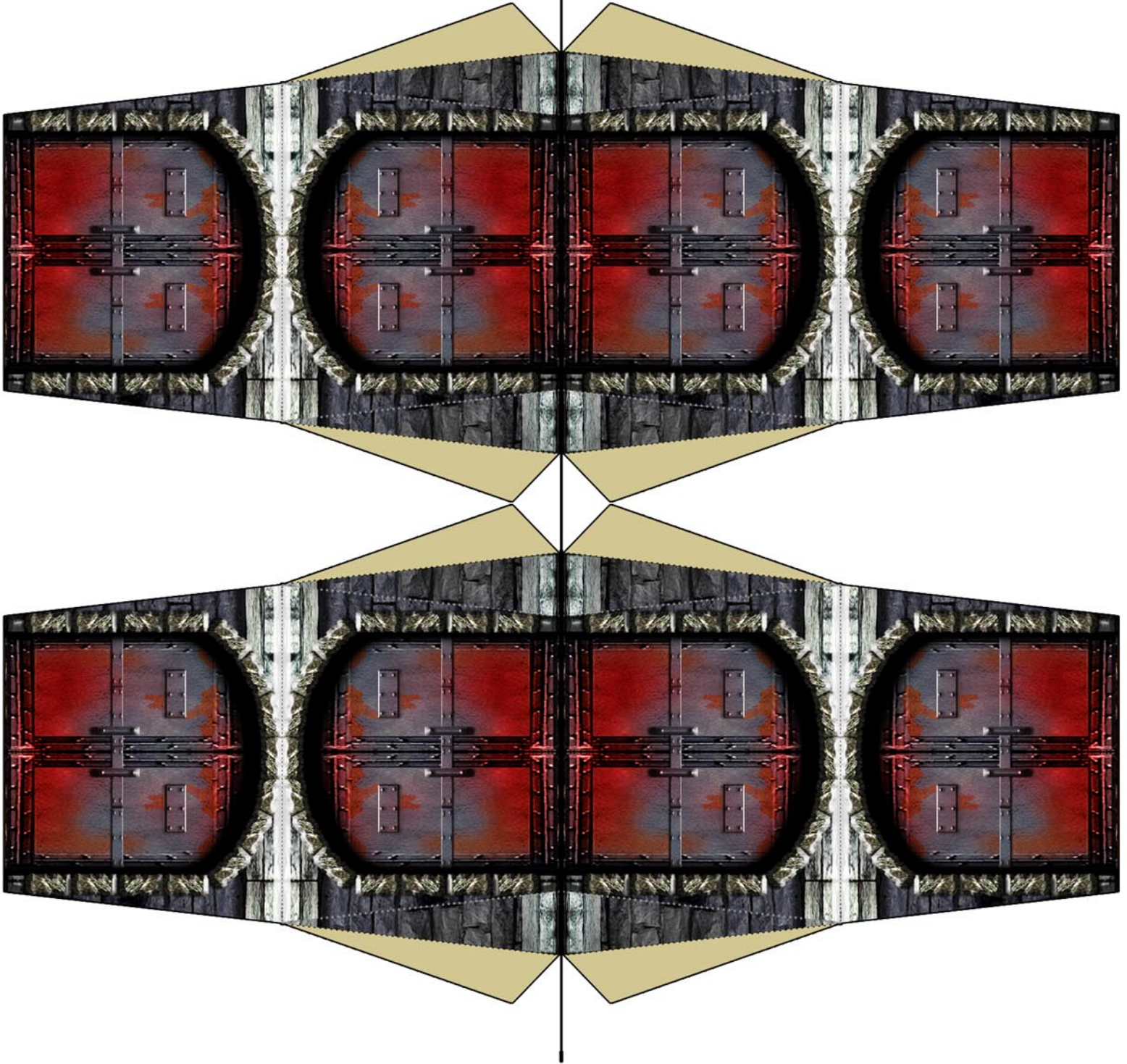
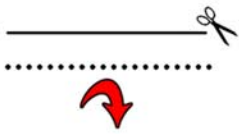
- Cut and score where marked. Be sure to cut straight through the dominant black line separating the models. Each sheet contains 4 doors.
- Fold your models where scored
- Glue the beige tabs (glue tabs) to the inside of the door section. **IMPORTANT:** As with most of the models in this set it is important that you use the Wooden Ruler Technique as noted in the beginners guide. It is impossible to get a good bond with your fingers alone on this model. When done properly the doors should form a sturdy triangular shape.
