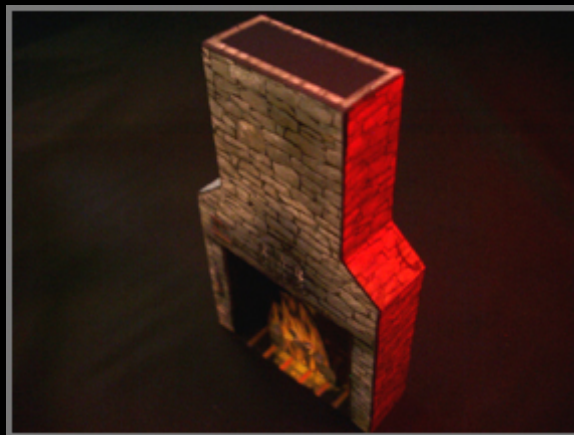




FIREPLACE



Difficulty Rating (Out of 10): 6 (The fireplace is a relatively complicated model but its well worth the effort!)

Recommended Duplications: 1-2 (It really depends on your dungeon concept but a couple of fireplaces should suit your needs just fine)

Steps:

- Cut and score where marked. Be sure to take care cutting the central fire opening that

you only remove the two small gray triangles. This area forms the inner walls of your fireplace. Refer to the above photos for reference. Pay careful attention to the three score sections that require reverse side scoring. Two are at the mid point of the sidewalls the final is on the base of the "pit" section.

- Fold your models along the score lines.
- Once you have folded your model you should have a good sense of how it all fits together. Glue the main fireplace section together along the beige tabs (glue tabs). **IMPORTANT:** As with most of the models in this set it is important that you use the Wooden Ruler Technique as noted in the beginners guide. It is impossible to get a good bond with your fingers alone on this model. When gluing the tabs for the inner walls of the fireplace, be sure to line them up so that they make an even rectangular shape (Refer to third photo).
- Take the fire section and glue its tab to the pit section where marked.
- Glue the pit section to the back wall of the fireplace.

Complete! The gift of heat, torture and atmosphere is now ready to be included in your twisted dungeon.
