

FIRE AND BEDDING



Quick note: I do apologize if some of the instruction sets are repetitive but many models follow the same steps.

Difficulty Rating: (Easy) If your group is spending days underground then they'll most certainly need a warm fire and some straw beds to keep things civil;)

Recommended Duplications: 1 sheet.

Steps

- Cut, score and fold where marked. It is important to be as accurate as
 possible with your scoring to prevent misaligned pieces. Be sure to cut
 the internal form of the fire only AFTER you have "sandwich glued" the
 entire section together. (Please read the "Beginners Guide" for proper
 cutting and scoring methods)
- Sandwich glue the fire section together. Be sure to allow a five minute dry time.
- Cut away the excess white space leaving only the flame and glue tabs.
 You may want to do this free hand depending on your skill level as it speeds things up.
- Bend out the glue tabs and test them for fit on the firepit stone base.
 Once you're happy with the position glue the fire in place. (See above photo)
- BEDDING: Either cut out as a rectangle or cut around the straw mound for a more realistic look.

Edging Color: Black felt (What is "Edging"? Refer to the "Beginners Guide" included with this model set)
