

STAIRS/ALTER



Difficulty Rating: (Advanced) This is a great hybrid model that pulls double duty as both stairs and an alter. To convert this model to "Alter Mode" simply bute two stair cases together end to end (Dont forget to "CLIP-IT" together).

Recommended Duplications: 2. At the very least you will need two stair cases.

Steps

- Unfortunatly there is no easy way to build a staircase but I think I'm getting close! Cut, score and fold where marked. It is important to be as accurate as possible with your scoring to prevent misaligned pieces. (Please read the "Beginners Guide" for proper cutting and scoring methods)
- Once you've folded the main staircase section (the one with the skulls on it) glue the stair tabs to the inside of the opposing wall.
- Once dry take the remaining stair section (folded like an accordian) and glue all of the white areas.
- Before your glue sets quickly seat the accordian piece inside the main staircase. (If you use white glue you should have ample play time to position the piece properly.)
- Apply pressure to each level of the stairs until dry.
- Finish the model by gluing the final two base tabs at the bottom of the staircase to the inside of the stair walls. (See above photos for reference)

Edging Color: Brown felt (What is "Edging"? Refer to the "Beginners Guide" included with this model set)
