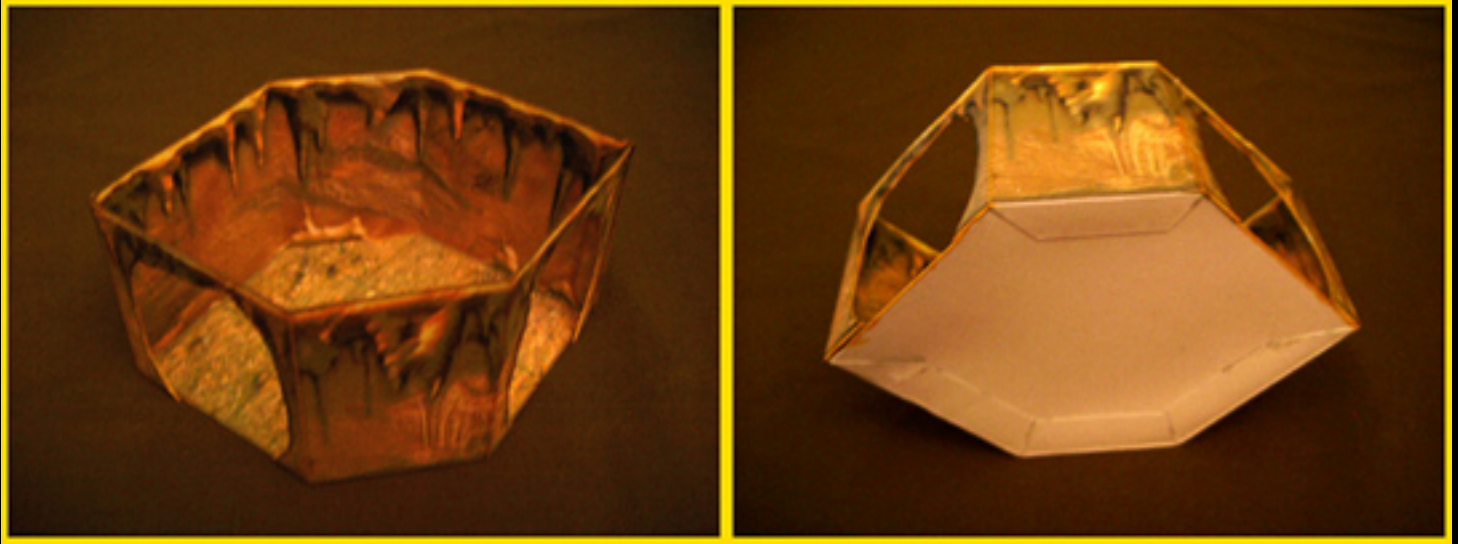




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CORNER



Quick note: I do apologize if some of the instruction sets are repetitive but many models follow the same steps.

Difficulty Rating: (Medium) An essential cave crawling model. Great for gradual turns and snaking corridors.

Recommended Duplications: 6 to 8. As always this is dependent on how expansive you wish your cave network to be.

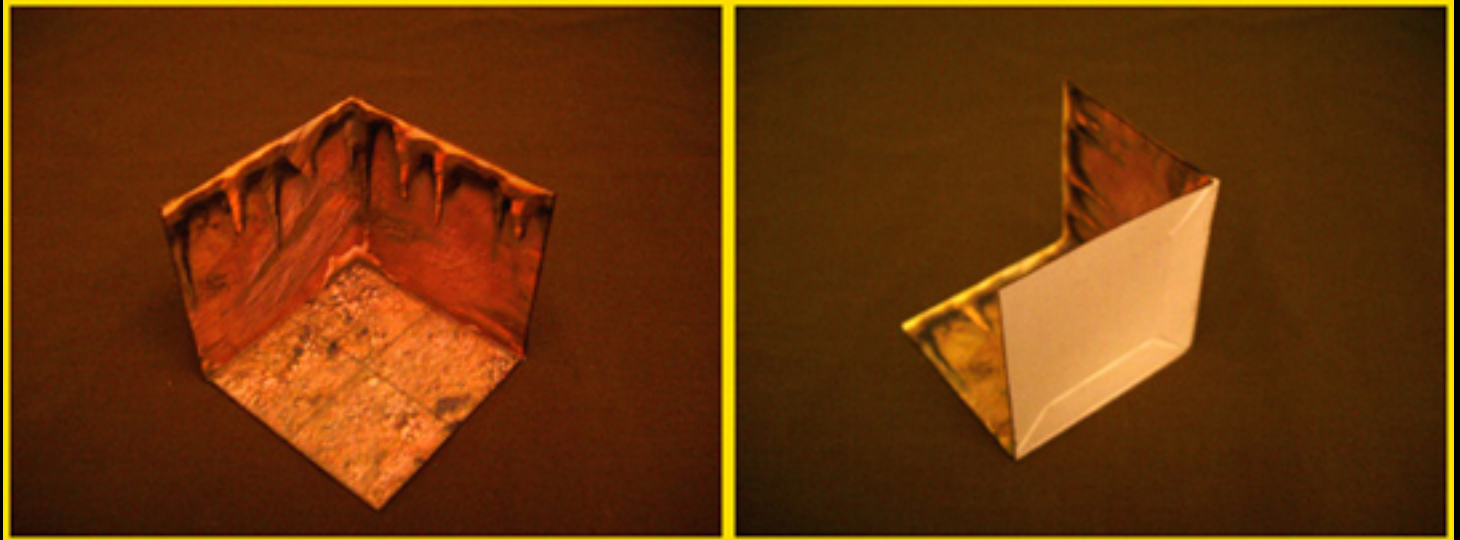
Steps

- Cut, score and fold where marked. It is important to be as accurate as possible with your scoring to prevent misaligned pieces. Be sure to cut away the cave openings only **AFTER** you have "sandwich glued" the entire wall section. *(Please read the "Beginners Guide" for proper cutting and scoring methods)*
- Fold over and glue or "sandwich glue" the individual wall sections. Allow a five minute drying time for sandwiched sections to prevent warping.
- After the walls have dried cut away the remaining cavern openings (White space).
- Glue the vertical wall section tabs to one another on the inside of the model frame.
- Once the completed wall frame is freestanding (But without a floor), apply glue to one of the base tabs and sit the floor tile within the wall frame.
- Flip the model over and apply glue to each of the remaining base tabs until the floor tile is secure and flat within the wall frame. *(See above photos for reference)*

QUICK TURN



Quick note: I do apologize if some of the instruction sets are repetitive but many models follow the same steps.

Difficulty Rating: (Easy) Very basic model ideal for areas requiring sharp, quick turns or to finish off corners of large cavernous spaces.

Recommended Duplications: 4 to 6. Chances are you won't require a large number of this model. Four should suit your needs just fine.

Steps

- Cut, score and fold where marked. It is important to be as accurate as possible with your scoring to prevent misaligned pieces. *(Please read the "Beginners Guide" for proper cutting and scoring methods)*
- Fold over and glue or "sandwich glue" the individual wall sections. Allow a five minute drying time for sandwiched sections to prevent warping.
- Once the completed wall frame is freestanding (But without a floor), apply glue to one of the base tabs and sit the floor tile within the wall frame.
- Flip the model over and apply glue to the remaining base tab until the floor tile is secure and flat within the wall frame. *(See above photos for reference)*
