



"Staircase"

The stairs are on the difficult side to explain in simple terms. So once again I bring you "Pretty Pictures";)


Cut, score and fold your model as marked. Pay attention to the reverse side scoring on the stair section (the straight piece). You should wind-up with the following (left photo). Start by gluing the stairs flush to the inside of the staircase wall (Right photo).




Apply glue to the white space on the top stair (Left Photo). Glue the top step to the underside of the main staircase. Continue gluing the stairs in this manner using the edge of your table as a support (Right Photo)



Glue the two bottom stair tabs in place.



Glue the top stair tab to the remaining back-wall section. Glue the final tab in place and apply pressure.



Sandwich glue the banister sections and then cutout the white space between them. Apply glue to the insides of the banisters and place on either side of the staircase. All done!
