Buildings of the World Series England Tower Bridge

The Tower Bridge is one of London's landmarks. It was built in 1894, on the eve of the 20th century. Between two towers designed in the style of a medieval castle is a drawbridge, which can be raised to allow large ships to pass beneath it on the Thames River. Until the 1970s, the bridge was operated by steam power.

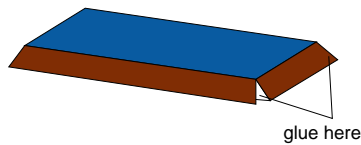

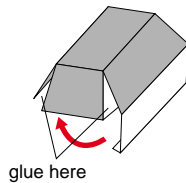
★Directions

Print out pages 1 through 3, cut out each individual part along their cut lines, and fold along the mountain and valley fold lines.

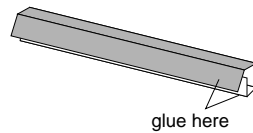
1. Build the base



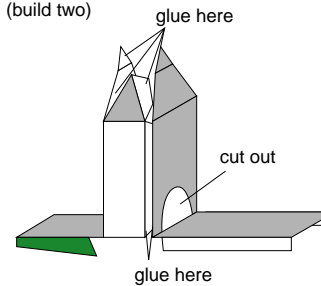
2. Build the girders (build two)



3. Build the beams (build two)

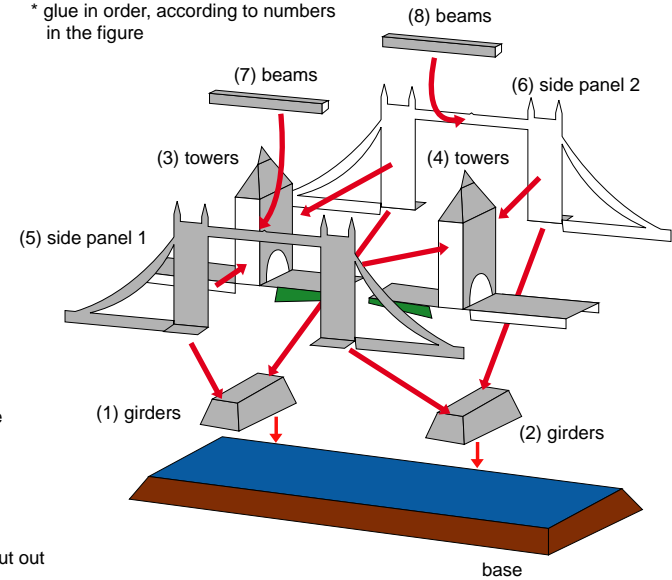


4. Build the towers (build two)
