

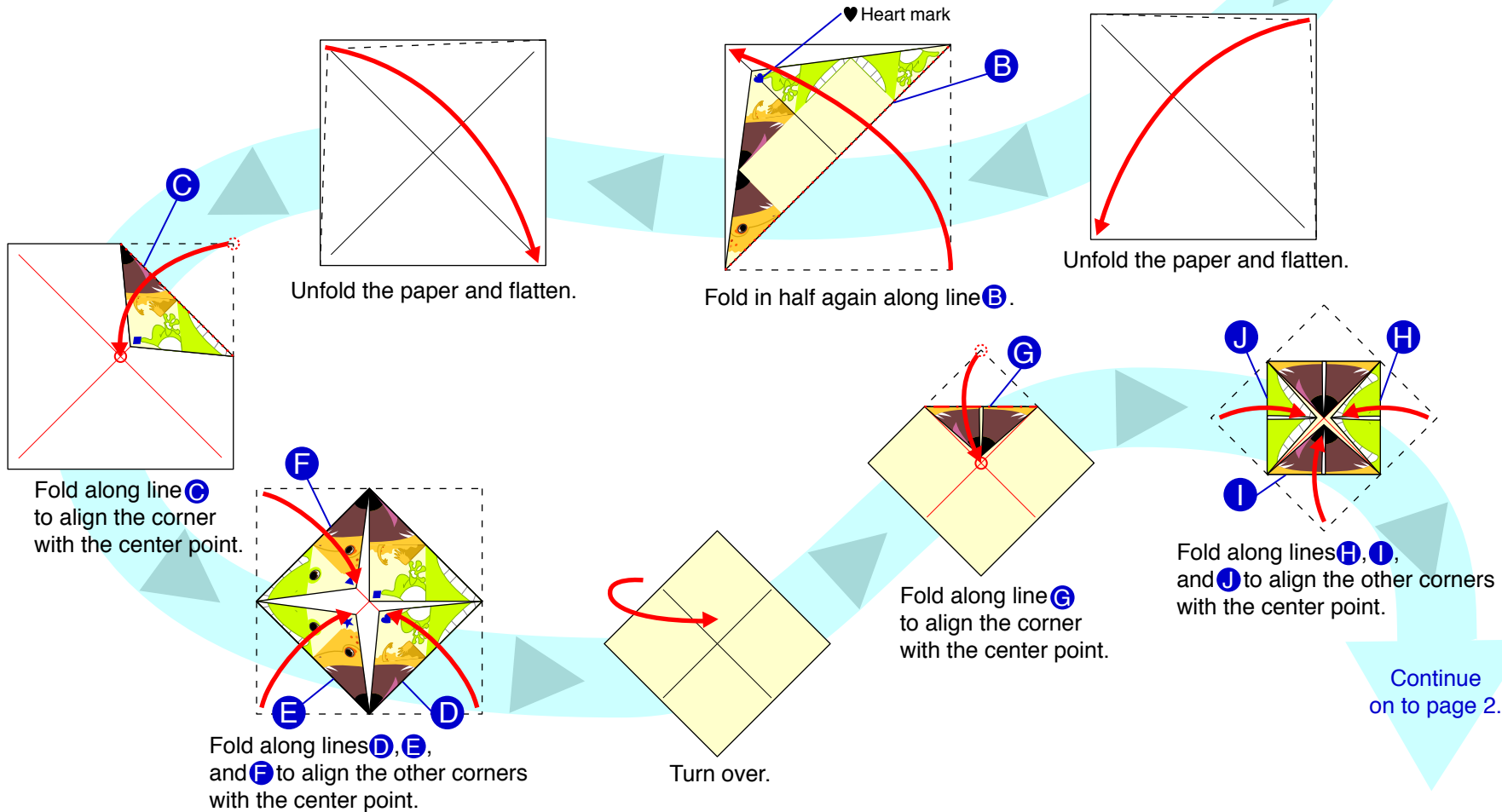
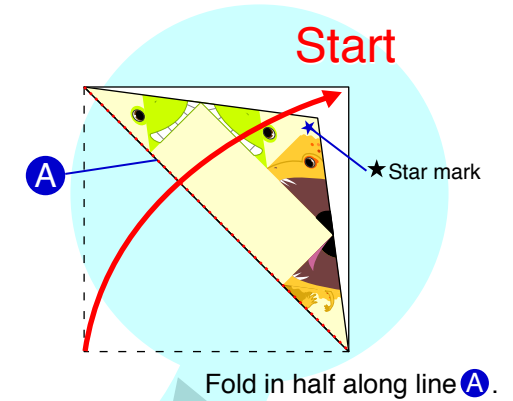


Catcher [A4 size 5pages]

The Catcher is a fun origami toy, which shows different pictures when it is opened horizontally and vertically. Have fun transforming your Catcher!

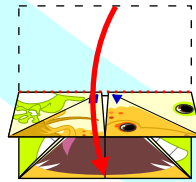
● The letters in blue circles indicate the fold lines. They are also shown on the practice sheet.



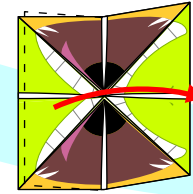

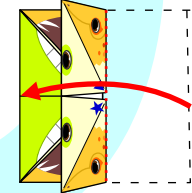
Grasp the upper corners
with your fingers.



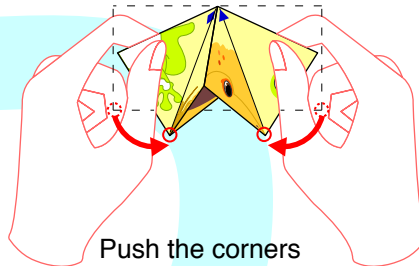
Fold in half horizontally.



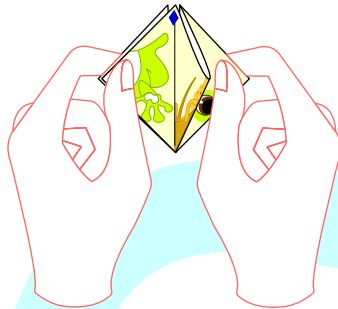
Unfold the paper and flatten.



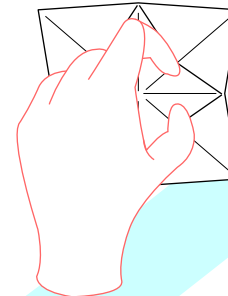
Fold in half vertically.



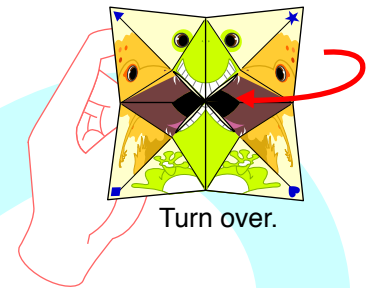
Push the corners

center to form a diamond shape.



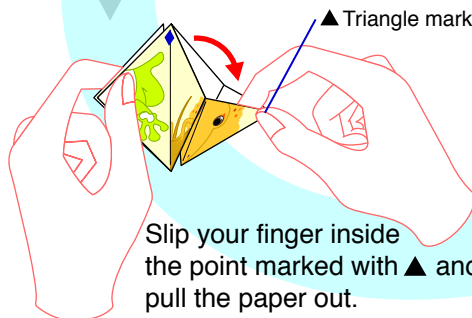
Diamond shape.

that were formed by opening
up the corners.

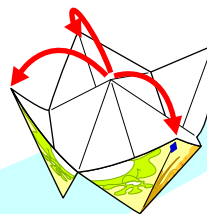


Turn over.



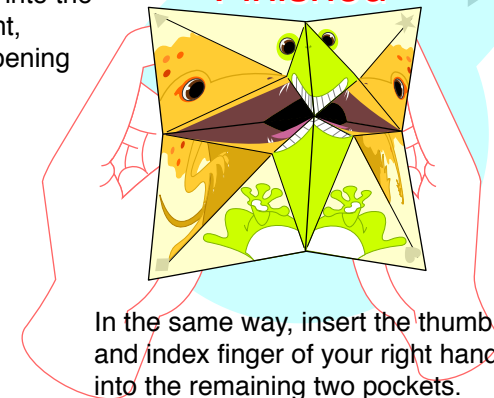
Slip your finger inside

pull the paper out.

▲ Triangle mark



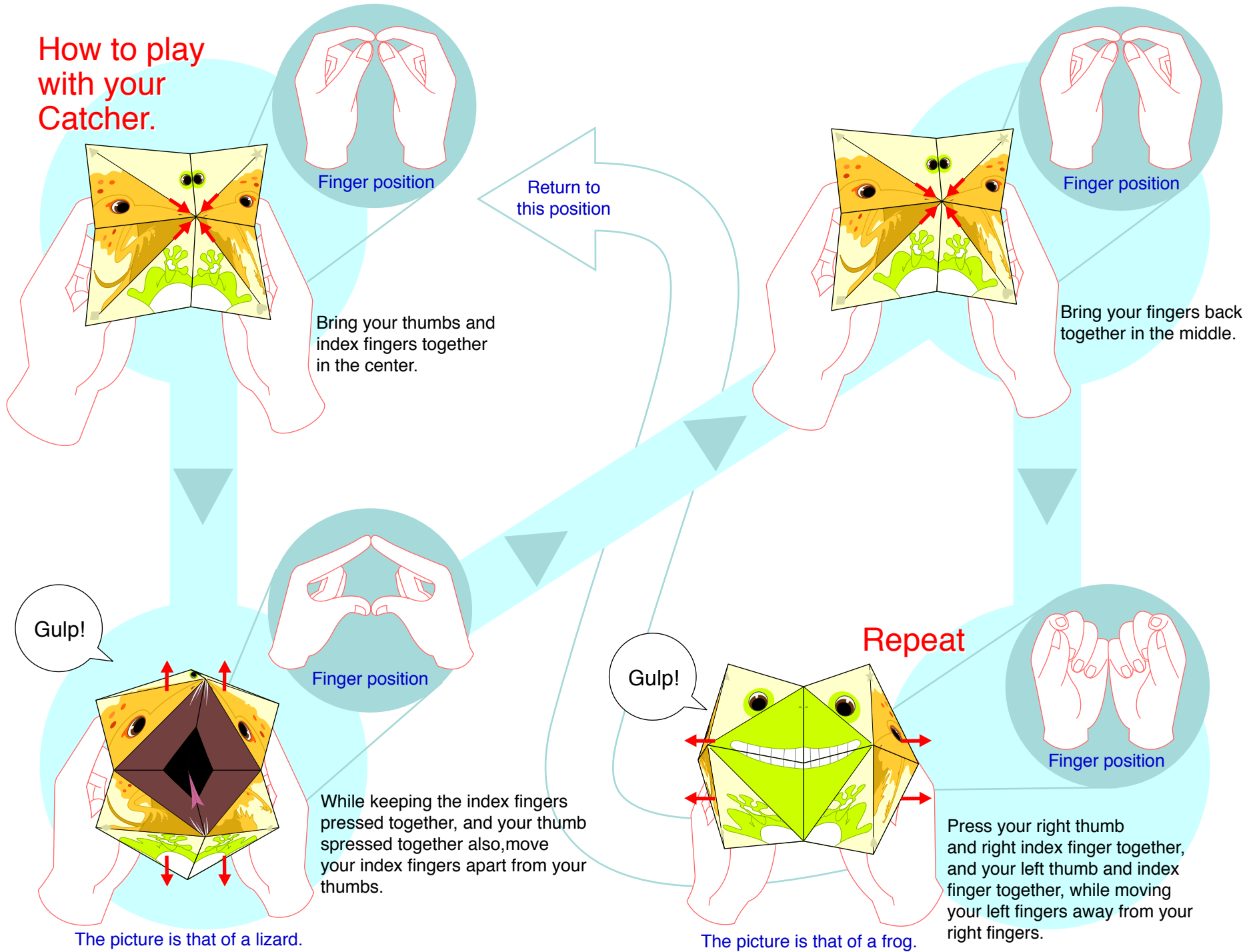
Fold out the other corners
in the same manner.

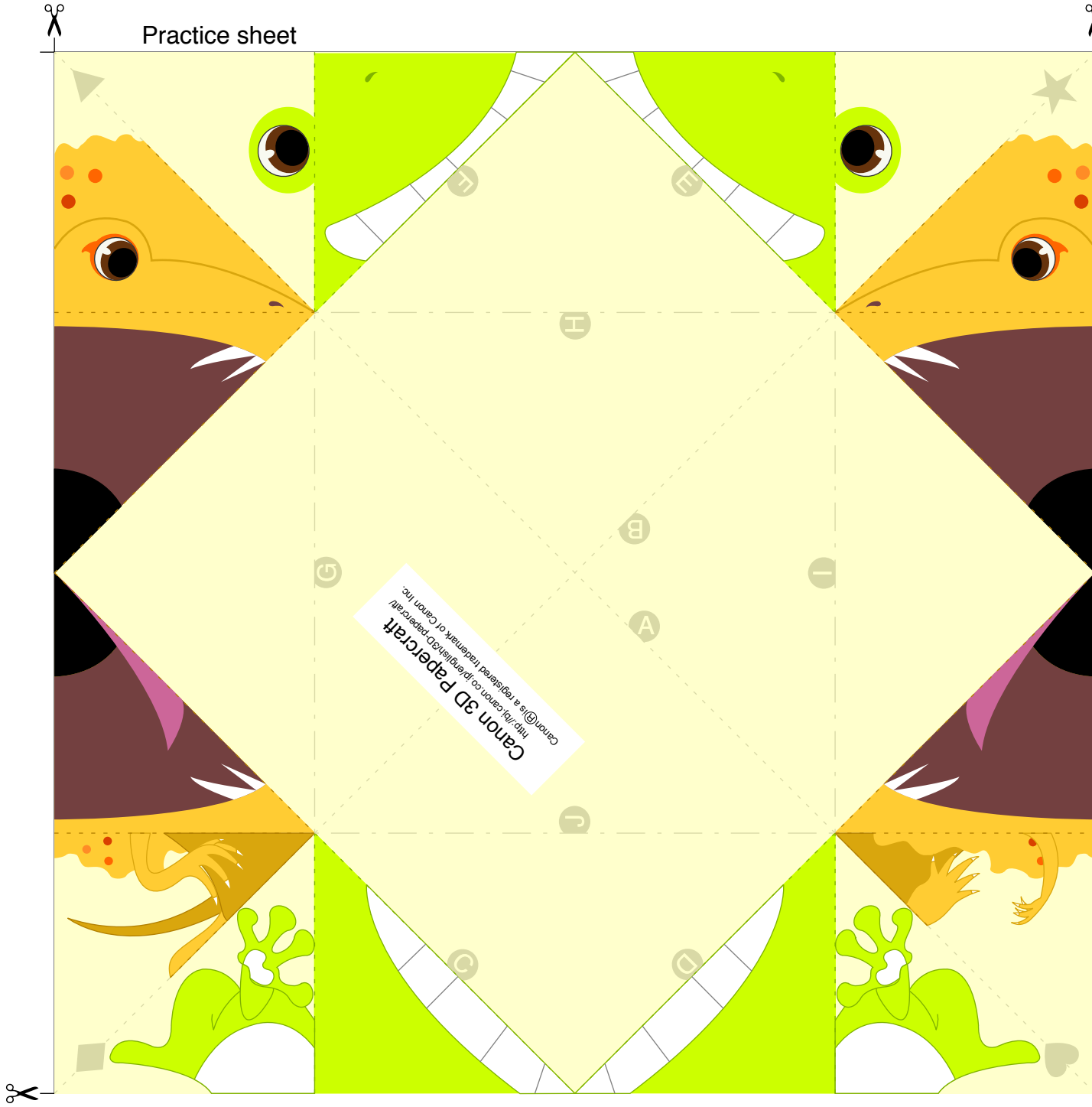
Finished

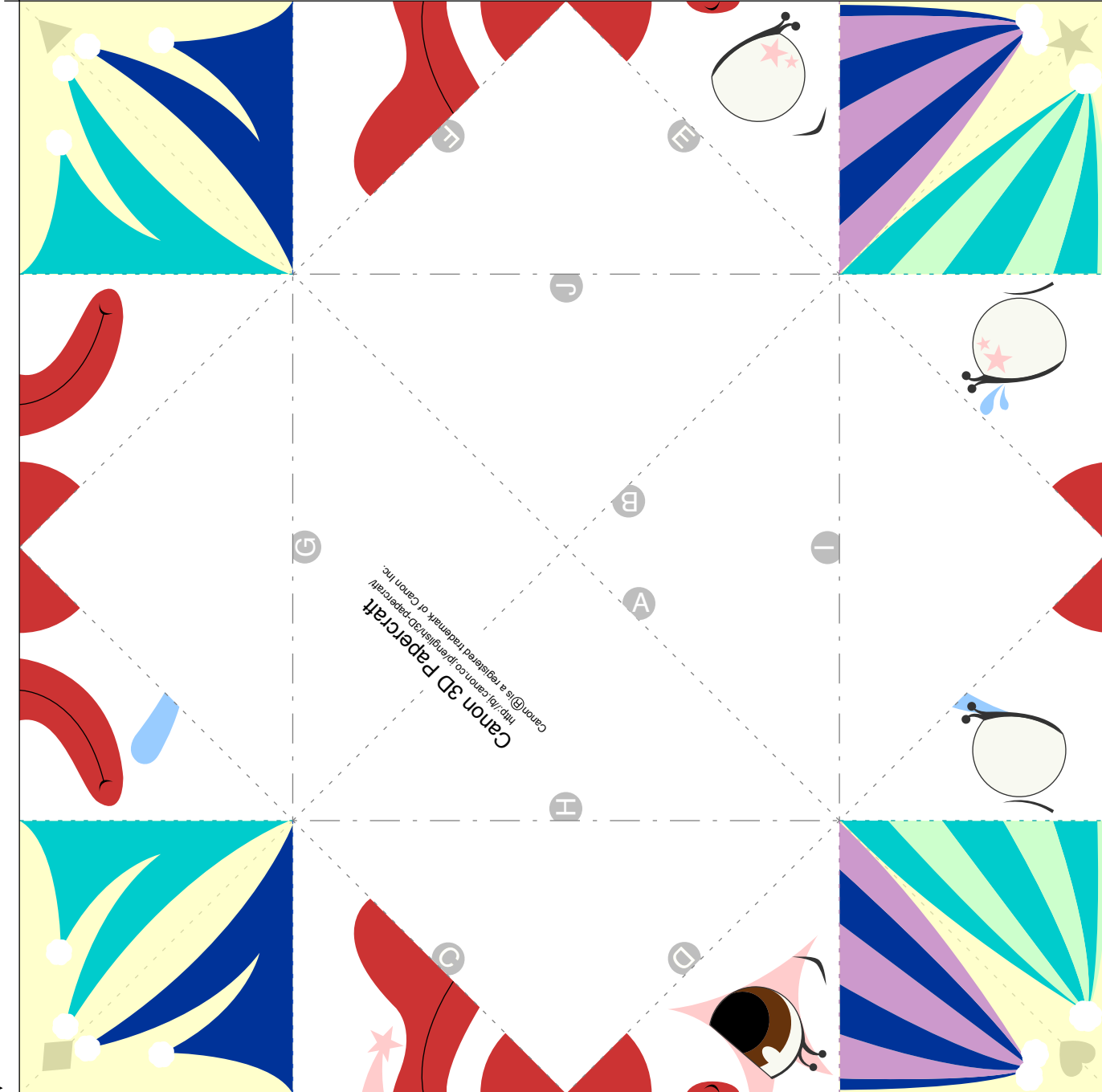
