






Catcher [A4 size 5pages]


There are various types of origami which have been done in Japan since ancient times.

The Catcher is a fun origami toy, which shows different pictures when it is opened horizontally and vertically. Have fun transforming your Catcher!


The letters in blue circles indicate the fold lines. They are also shown on the practice sheet.




Fold in half along line A.




Unfold the paper and flatten.




Fold in half again along line B.




Unfold the paper and flatten.



Fold along line (to align the corner with the center point.




Fold along lines (), (=), and to align the other corners with the center point.



Turn over.


Fold along line (6) to align the corner with the center point.




Fold along lines (1), (1), and 1 to align the other corners with the center point.

Continue on to page 2.










Fold in half horizontally.
















center to form a diamond shape.






Diamond shape.










Fold out the other corners in the same manner.
