

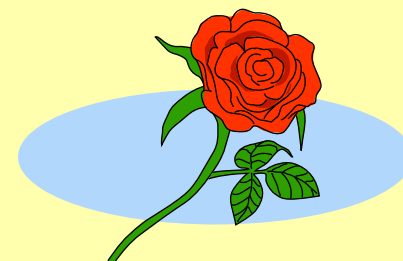


Father's Day (third Sunday in June)

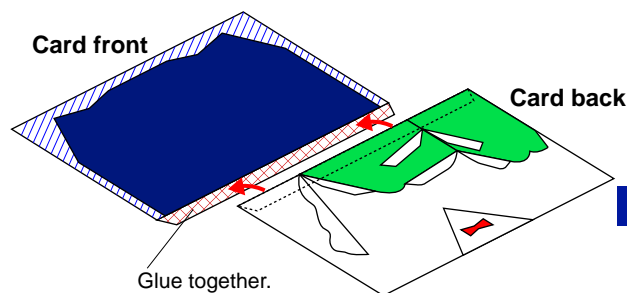
Today it's customary to give fathers roses or presents. You can use this handmade, three-dimensional card to express your gratitude to your father.



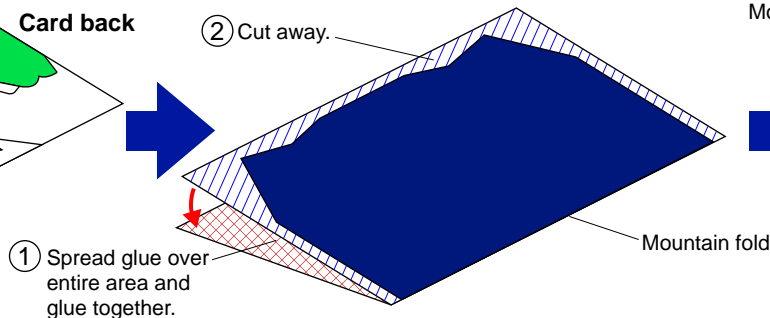
★How to build it

Print out the pages. Cut out all the parts and fold along the fold lines.

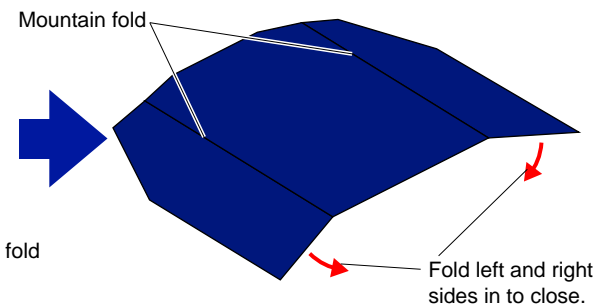
1. Glue the card front and back together.



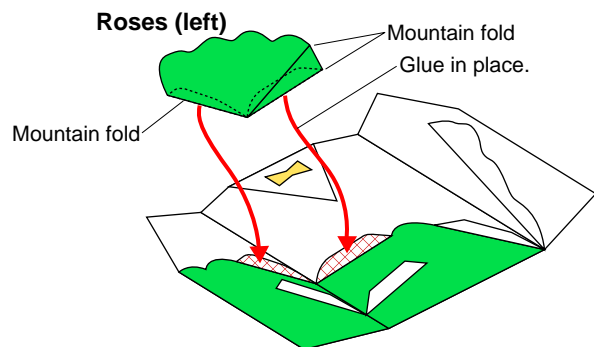
2. Fold in two and glue together. Then cut away the area shaded with blue diagonal lines.



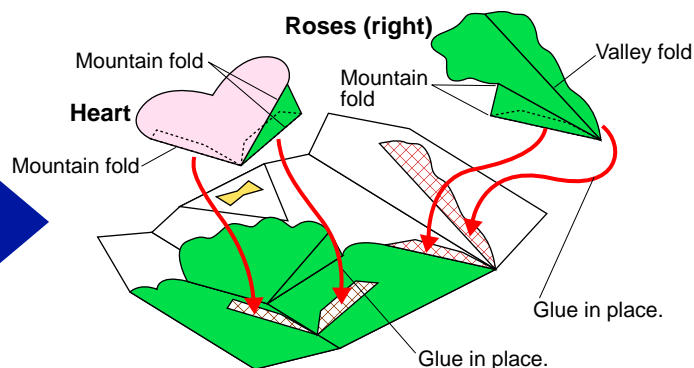
3. Fold left and right sides of card in to close.



4. Turn over, open, and glue roses (left) in place.

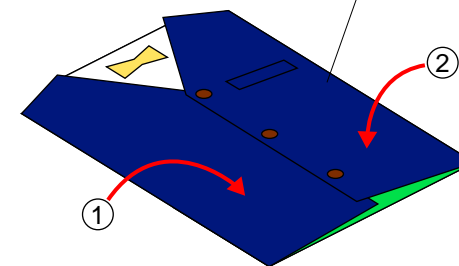


5. Glue heart and roses (right) in place.



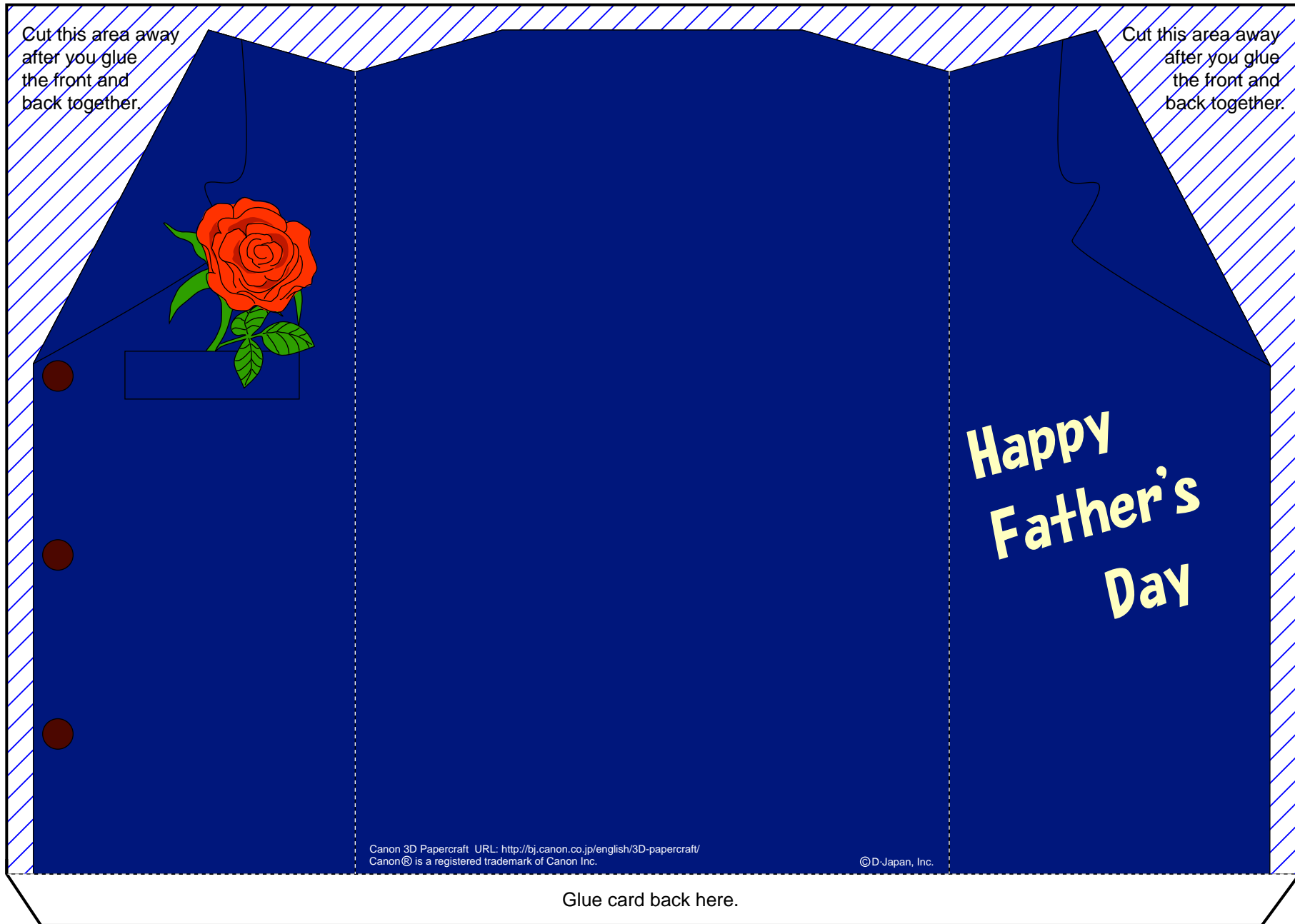
★How to fold

Taking care that the heart and flowers inside don't show, fold together with the button side on top.

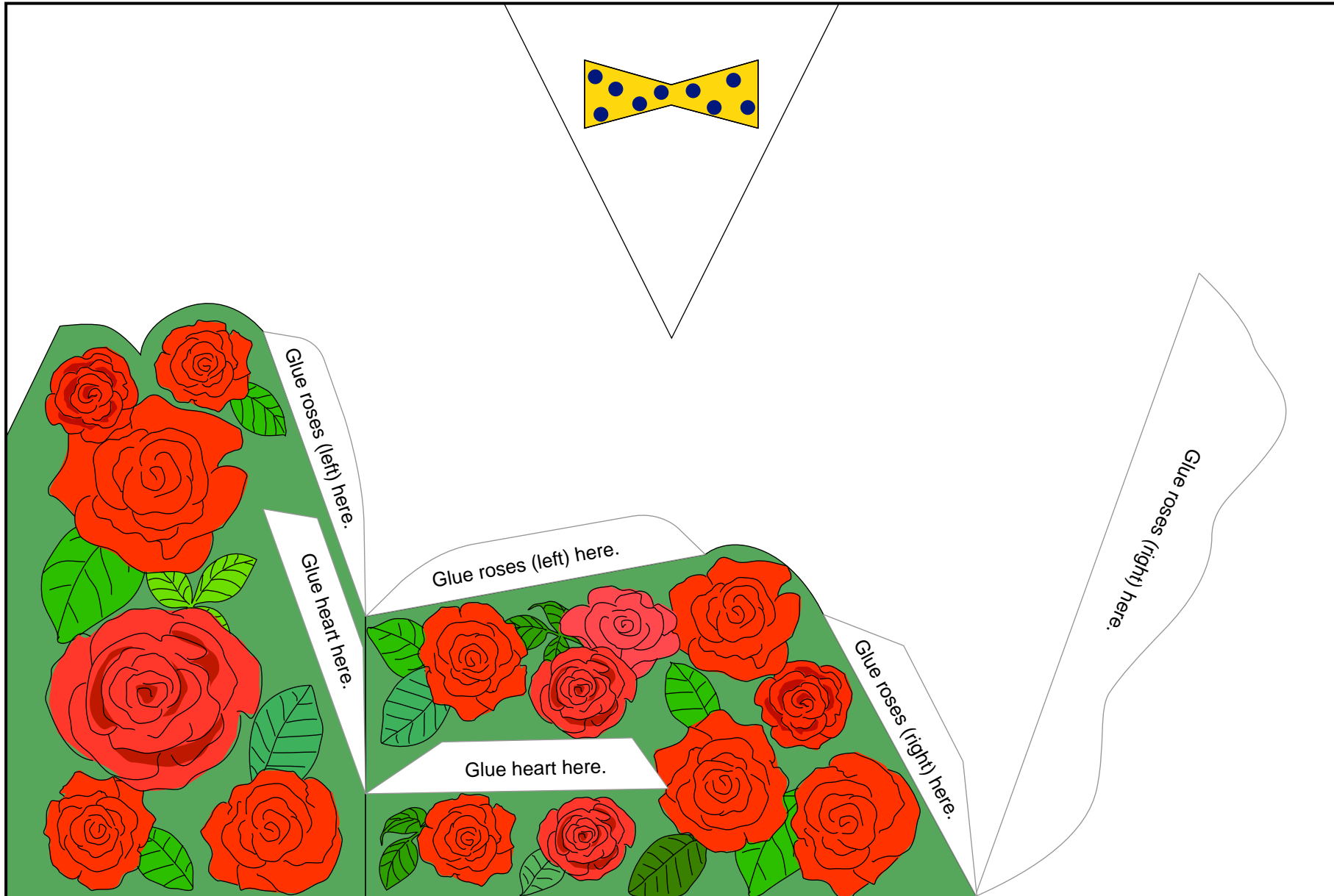


— cut line

Card front

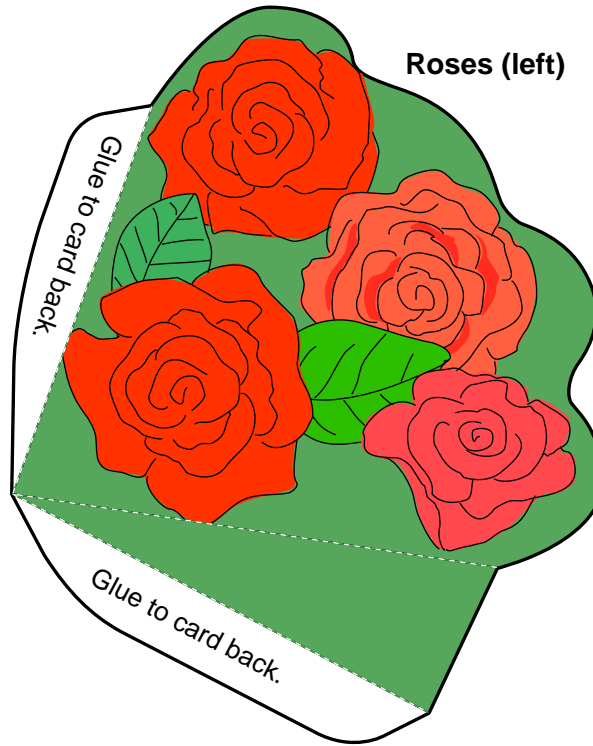


Card back

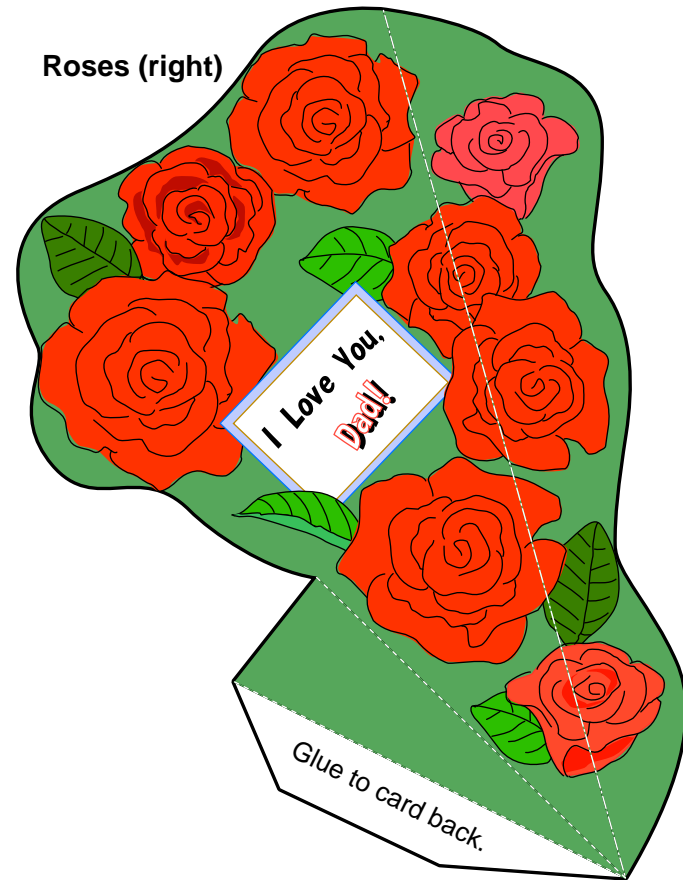


- cut line
