


Charles A. Lindbergh



Curve the body slightly to help it stand up better


Statue of Liberty




Curve the body slightly to help it stand up better




bend forward to stand upright


Tail (part 6)




Starboard landing gear (part 4)




Airplane body (part 1)




Port landing gear (part 5)




Wings (part 2)




Propeller (part 3)




