## Santa Hat



Santa Claus is modeled after Saint Nicholas, a bishop who lived in Turkey in the fourth century AD. The name "Santa Claus" came into use in the 18th century in America.

Saint Nicholas helped many people in distress, particularly children. One famous story tells of him dropping money down the chimney of the house where three poor sisters lived. The money is said to have fallen into their stockings, which had been hung up near the fireplace to dry.

The tale of a Santa Claus who traveled around on Christmas Eve in a sleigh pulled by reindeers delivering presents to children was written in the 1800s in America. The poem was widely published in newspapers, magazines, and picture books, and that version of the story quickly spread around the world. Santa's red suit and hat are said to symbolize his efforts to bring happiness to people.

All around the world there are tales of a Santa Claus figure, sometimes in the form of a witch or a king. In all these stories, Santa makes children happy by bringing them presents.




#### 1 Build the left half of the CROWN



③ Glue on the POM-POM.




② Glue together.

② Glue together.



### 4 Build the FUR TRIM






**FUR TRIM (OUTSIDE)**

Align the glue tabs C on the inside and glue together. Align the star (★) marks on the outside and glue together.




### 5 Glue the FUR TRIM to the CROWN




### 6 Build the ADJUSTER

If the hat is too large for you, use the ADJUSTER to make it fit right.





### 7 Build the BEARD

\* This pattern includes adult-sized and child-sized BEARDS. These directions apply to both.




### 8 Attach the ADJUSTER and BEARD


