Tongkonan high-floored dwelling

The beautiful roof, full of character and dignity, is shaped like a boat. It is said that this style is a vestige of the fact that the people of this area were once a seafaring people. This traditional, high-floored house is found on the Indonesian island of Sulawesi. The houses are divided by a sill into east and west portions, with the west side used for sleeping and eating.

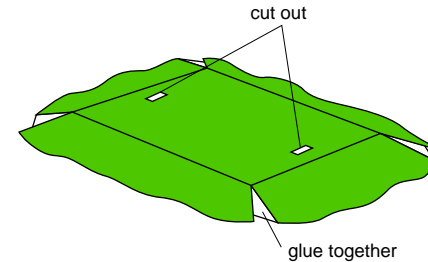

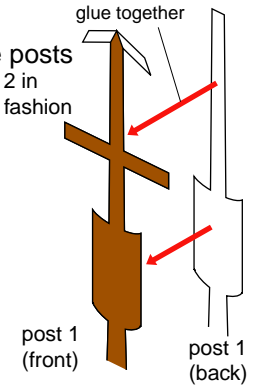
Print out pages 1 through 5, cut out each individual part along their cut lines, and fold along the mountain and valley fold lines.

1. Build the base



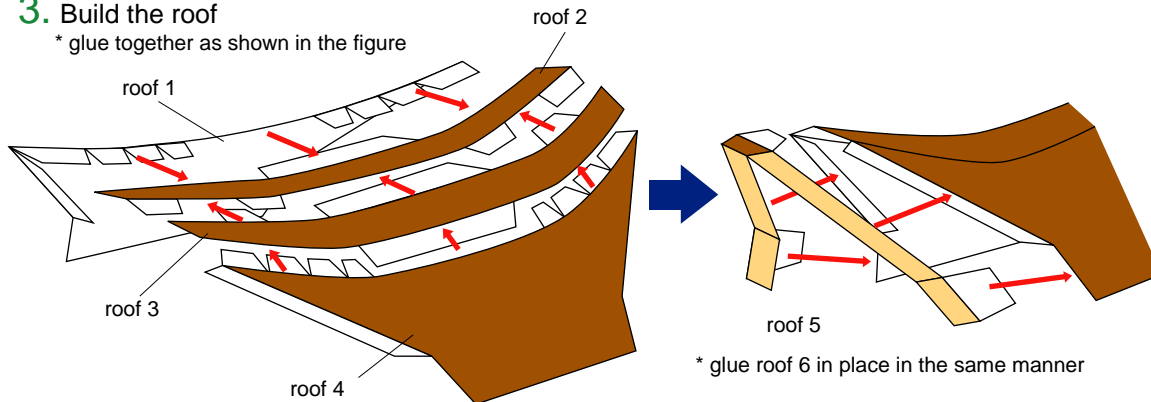
2. Build the posts

* build post 2 in the same fashion

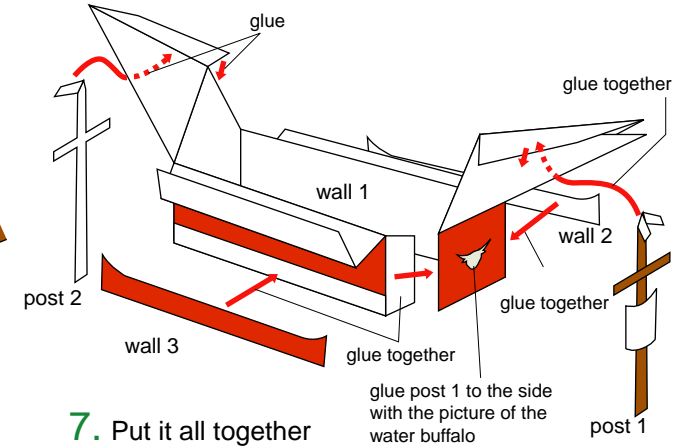


3. Build the roof

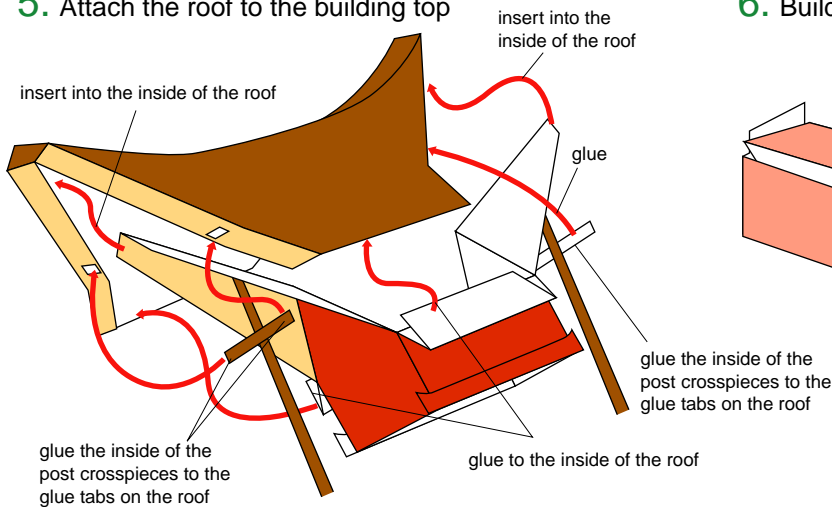
* glue together as shown in the figure



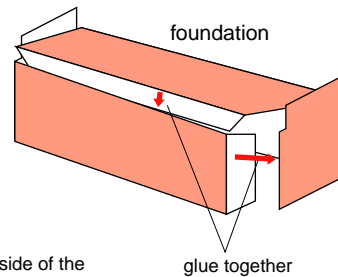
4. Assemble the wall



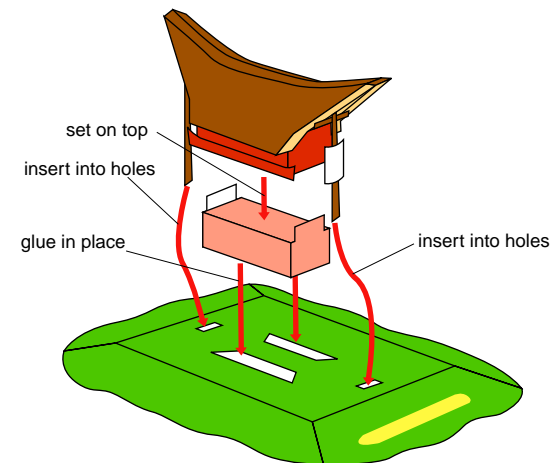
5. Attach the roof to the building top

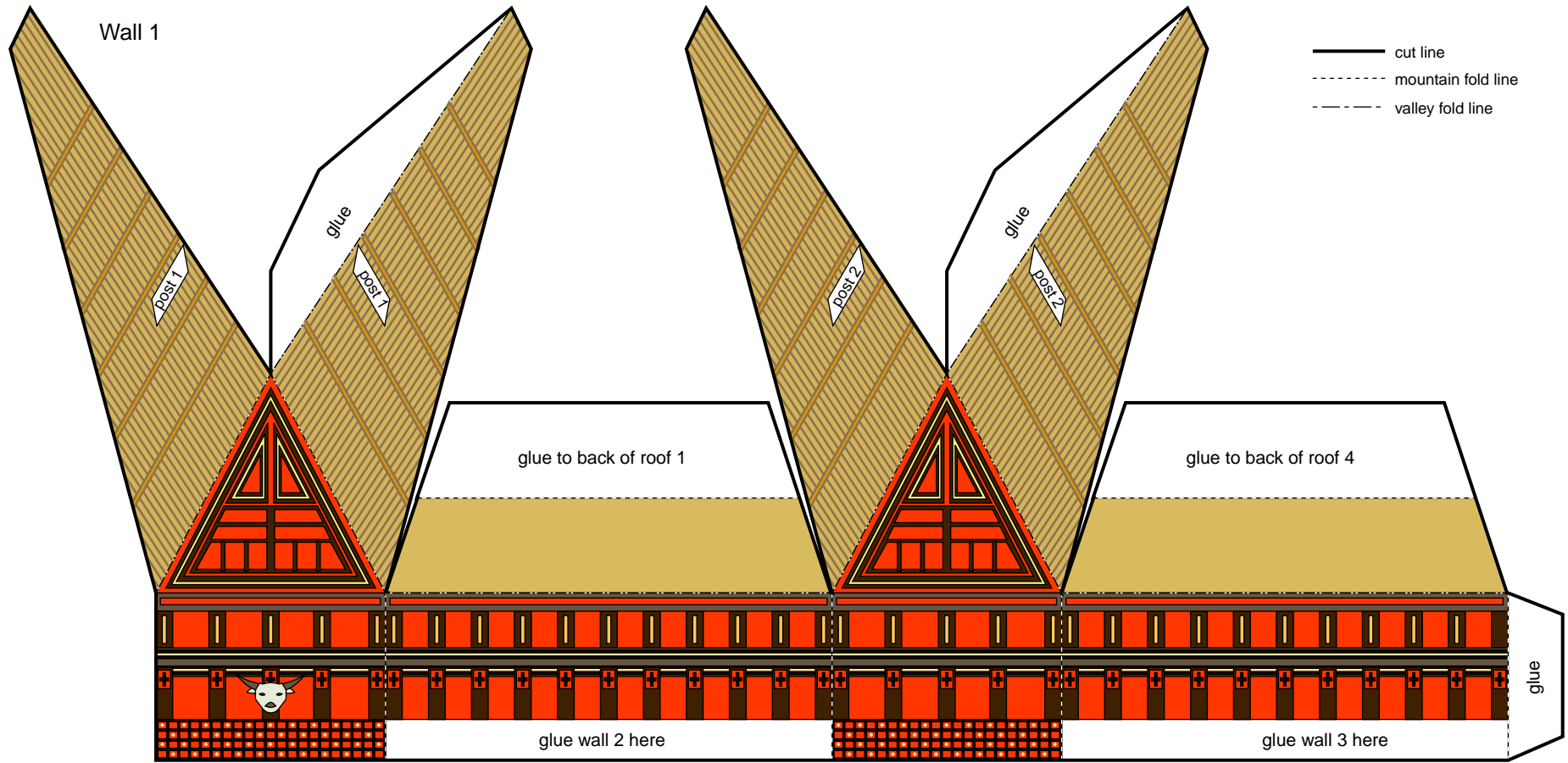


6. Build the foundation

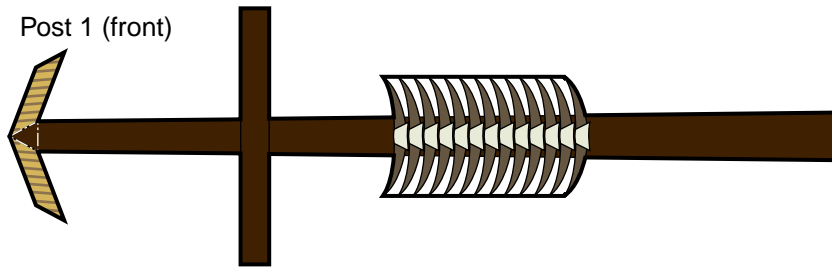


7. Put it all together

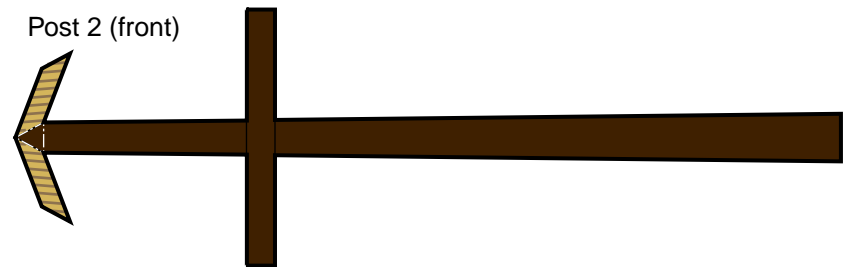




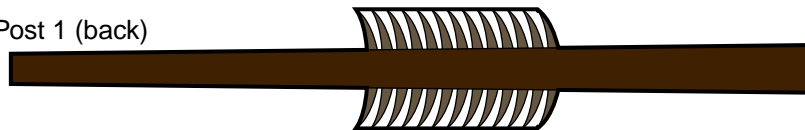

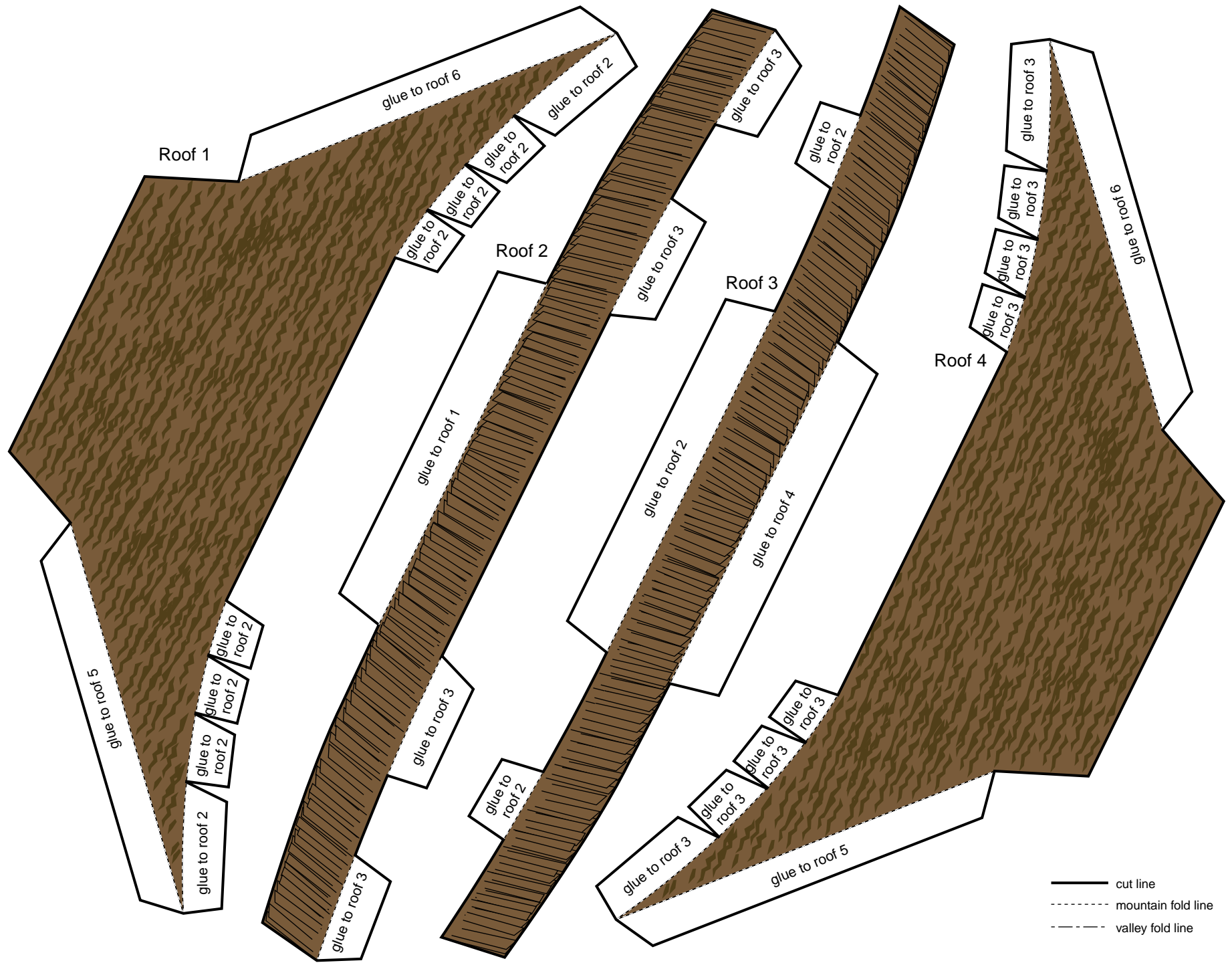


Post 1 (back)

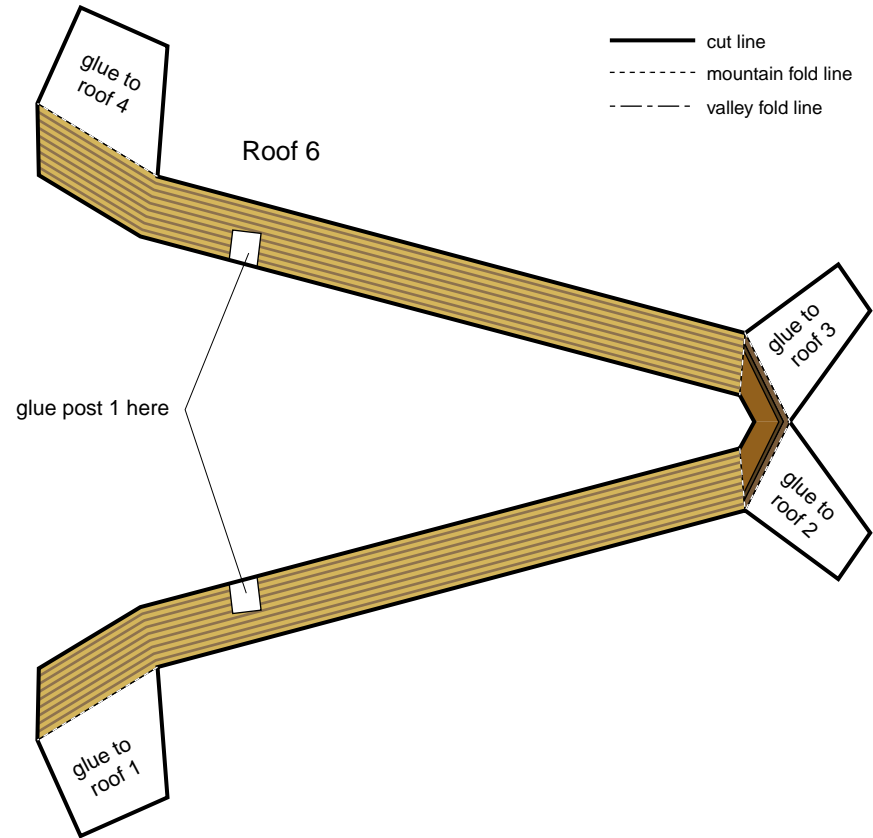
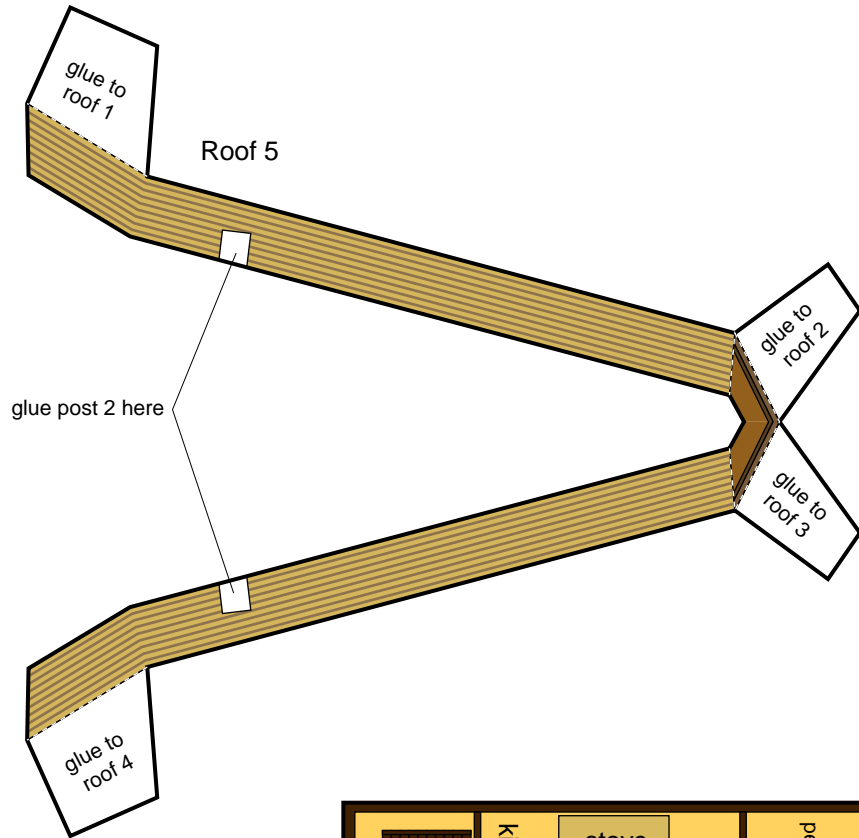
